



HUMAN TRAFFICKING

Forms of Exploitation



Criminal vs Victim

Criminalization Prosecution

- accepting fees for acts
- force person into acts
- coercion of person for acts
- inducing person based on fraud into acts

Protection Provision

- victim identification, victim protections
- victims right to non-legal threat, rights to safety, right to privacy, right to information

Crimes against persons associated with Human Trafficking

Provision

- Shelter
- Medical Care
- Job training
- Confidential legal proceedings
- Legal Counsel
- Education and training opportunities
- Consideration of special needs and child care

Prosecution

- Thorough investigation
- Trial and conviction
- Training of law enforcement officials
- Extradition
- Extraterritoriality

Prevention

- Adopt and strengthen legislation to discourage the demand of commercial exploitation
- Comprehensive anti-trafficking legislation
- Research
- Education and awareness
- Alleviate social and economic barriers for vulnerable populations
