## **Called Meeting Minutes**

- A. Proof of Notice, Confirm Quorum & Call to Order: 7:08 pm
  - 1. **Present**: Lillian Parks-Johnson (923 Middle Run Place), Ken Daniels (1427 Big Stone Gap Rd), Deena Williams (1310 Crosspointe St), Evelyn Slough (907 Middle Run Place), Chelsea Haynes (Manager, Goodwin & Co.)
  - 2. Absent: Liz Wilson (1308 Crosspointe St), Josh Pielage (1403 Big Stone Gap)
- B. Approval of Prior Meeting Minutes November 6th, 2024
  - 1. Amendments: Change Lillian's last name from Parker-Jones to Parks-Johnson, and clarify that the \$25k in pool expenses was not exclusively for resurfacing
  - 2. Deena moved, and Evelyn seconded, motion to approve November 6, 2024, open meeting minutes with amendments; approved without objection (4-0)
- C. Summary of actions taken during November 6th Executive Board meeting
  - Lillian: Offered to distribute notification to all members to advise them to pay before December 1
- D. Treasurer's Report
  - 1. Financial Review
    - a. As of 12/31/2024, we had total cash of \$147,383 vs \$136,683 as of 12/31/2024, for a year-over-year increase of over \$10k
    - b. Invested \$30k in CD and \$30k in I Bonds, which can be withdrawn when needed. Planning to add another \$10k I bonds soon.
- E. Committee Reports (3 mins per committee)
  - 1. Welcome (Carol King)
    - a. **826 Middle Run**: Ms. Coy recently passed away without including the house in a will. Carol spoke with her son, who is not yet sure what he will do.
    - b. 855 Middle Run: Vacant, for sale
    - c. 620 Carriage Way: Vacant, for lease
  - 2. Architectural Control (**Don Adair**, not present)
    - a. **Juanita Lesmes** (807 Middle Run): 1412 Crosspointe is not in good order and is still under construction. **Chelsea**: Noted for further investigation
  - 3. Beautification (Lee Austin, not present)
  - 4. Amenities (Lillian Parks-Johnson)
    - Shout out to Charlene Daniels for decorating and to Demetrius Ethley for directing choir at Christmas party
    - b. We came in under budget for Christmas and got decorations for next year
- F. Old Business
  - 1. Erosion/engineering for Harlan residence
    - a. Chelsea: Obtained two new proposals for flume construction
      - 1) Van submitted CCGMC proposal for \$17,995

- 2) Mark Harlan submitted additional proposal
- b. **Clinton Franklin** (704 Carriage Way): Asked whether the Harlans agreed to hold The Greene harmless in the construction of the flume.
- c. Ken made motion to engage J3 Construction and Services to construct the flume as quoted for \$13,800, pending affirmation that the Harlans will hold the Greene harmless; approved without objection (4-0)
- 2. Governing Documents Revisions/Feedback
  - a. **Chelsea**: Attempted to schedule meetings with committee; one meeting with only Don in attendance. Will plan to send scheduling email to committee by Friday for February dates. Will send out survey to members for topics to include.
- 3. Homeowner Financials
  - a. **Chelsea**: Financial statements are available to members on TownSq and to public on our website (thegreenehoa.com)
- 4. CD Investing
  - a. Chelsea: Invested \$30k in an 11-month CD
- 5. Tennis Court Resurfacing
  - a. Ken: Prefer to wait on tennis court until after flume construction
  - b. **Mack Graham** (623 Old Country Rd): What is faulty with the tennis court? **Clinton**: It's starting to pucker in parts due to rain. Nice to have but not needed now.
  - c. **Juanita**: Belt that retains the tennis court net is slipping. **Ken**: Will let Josh know about it to address it.
- G. New Business
  - 1. Open for Board Discussion: no dicscussion
  - 2. Bond Investment
    - Ken made, and Evelyn seconded, motion make another \$10k I bond investment for 2025; approved without objection (4-0).
    - b. Ken made, and Deena seconded, motion to invest \$20k in a new CD; approved without objection (4-0)
- H. Homeowner Forum (2 minutes per owner)
  - Juanita: Observed a couple of business-related cars parked in lot near Crosspointe/Carriage Way/Wheatland Parking lots for at least 3-4 days. Asked whether they were in violation of 72 hour parking policy
  - 2. **Clinton**: Will address the question of business operations in the governing documents revision
  - 3. **Juanita**: Is our ranger (Corey Williams) still working for us? His weekly worksheet is not on clubhouse window. **Evelyn**: Expressed she is more concerned that the work be done, and commented that the Greene is looking good. **Juanita**: She picked up a lot of trash in December. **Mack**: Corey has done a lot of work moving tree branches Mack has cut
  - 4. **Carol King**: Reminded group that Liz and Josh were asked to investigate unregistered cars parked at ranger house
