

Tech Week Important Reminders

- Tech week rehearsals will be at the Curtis Theatre located at 1 Civic Center Circle, Brea, CA 92821 starting on Monday, Feb. 27th. All students will be performing in three shows at the Curtis Theatre in Brea. Tickets are almost completely sold out! The performance will run approximately 90 minutes including an intermission.
- Please remember the importance of school. School comes first. Students are not to miss any school because of Tech Week Rehearsals or the Performances.
- The FULL CAST is expected to attend every day of tech week. If you must be absent from a scheduled rehearsal or performance due to an unforeseen emergency, please let us know by email ASAP.
- Please <u>feed your kiddos</u> before each rehearsal OR send them to rehearsal with a sack dinner or snacks and a bottled water. We are not allowed to eat in the theater but we will give them the opportunity to eat in the courtyard when the opportunity arises.
- Pack your children something to do during down-time! They can pack any quiet work, homework, books, coloring books, crayons, stickers, etc. to keep them occupied. <u>PLEASE NO ELECTRONICS</u>. We do not want to be responsible for lost or broken items. Label all belongings and have your kiddos carry them in a small bag to avoid losing anything.

Students are allowed to leave with their parents or guardians after the matinee show which is expected to be over by 3:30pm. We only ask that they change out of their costume before heading out of the theater. If your student will be staying at the theater in between shows, please be sure to pack them a sack dinner and bottled water.

COSTUMES:

Costumes will be handed out during Tech rehearsal on Monday. Most costumes will be kept at the theater with the exception of LEOPARDS and MONKEYS. Please have your child come prepared for each rehearsal and performance with the proper undergarments, hair, & shoe requests set by Stagelight below.

TK-2nd Grade Girls LEOPARDS

- Hair: two high pigtail buns so they look like ears. See image below.
- Undergarments: light colored tank top/t-shirt and biker shorts or dance shorts.
- Shoes: black sneakers or ballet slippers. No flashy colors please.





TK-2nd Grade Boys MONKEYS

- Hair: no special requests. Monkey costumes are not tight and hooded over their head.
- Undergarments: light colored tank top/t-shirt and basketball or cotton shorts (no jeans)
- Shoes: black sneakers. No flashy colors please.

<u>3rd Grade - 5th Grade Girls (ZEBRAS, BIRDS, GISELLES, GRASS, LIONESS)</u>

- Hair: Low ponytail or bun. Many costumes have headpieces, hats or a hood.
- Undergarments: Light colored unitard and light colored or nude tights (tights are not required but highly suggested) They can wear a light colored tank top and biker shorts if they do not have a unitard.
- Shoes: black sneakers. No flashy colors please.
- Makeup: Production team will be applying all stage makeup to those who need it.

3rd Grade - 5th Grade Boys (HYENAS/WILDEBEESTS)

- Hair: no special requests.
- Undergarments: white or light colored tank top/t-shirt and basketball or cotton shorts (no jeans)
- Shoes: black sneakers. No flashy colors please.
- Makeup: production team will be applying all stage makeup to those who need it.
