Achieving remission in Dec. 2017, she suffered a relapse in April 2018. After 3 more rounds of chemo, an Autologous stem cell transplant in Nov 2018 finally brought sustained remission. Battling fear and exhaustion, frequent hospital stays distanced her from her young twins. Choosing Dana Farber meant enduring more treatments, including a month-long transplant recovery.
