

PRIVACY POLICY

OmegaTech-Int (“**Company**,” “**we**,” “**us**,” or “**our**”) is committed to protecting your privacy. This Privacy Policy explains how we collect, use, disclose, and safeguard your information when you visit our website located at www.omegatech-int.com (the “**Site**”). By accessing or using the Site, you (“**User**,” “**you**,” or “**your**”) consent to the data practices described in this Privacy Policy. If you do not agree with the terms of this Privacy Policy, please do not access or use the Site.

1. Information We Collect

We may collect information about you in a variety of ways. The information we may collect on the Site includes:

- a. **Personal Data.** Personally identifiable information, such as your name, email address, telephone number, postal address, and any other information you voluntarily provide to us when you register on the Site, place an order, subscribe to our newsletter, respond to a survey, fill out a form, or otherwise communicate with us. We collect personal data only when you provide it to us directly.
- b. **Usage Data.** Information automatically collected when you access the Site, including your Internet Protocol (IP) address, browser type and version, operating system, access times, pages viewed, the pages you visited before navigating to the Site, and other diagnostic data. This information is used to analyze trends, administer the Site, track user movements, and gather demographic information.
- c. **Cookies and Tracking Technologies.** We use cookies, web beacons, tracking pixels, and other tracking technologies to collect information about your browsing activities on the Site. Cookies are small data files stored on your device that help us improve the Site and your experience, see which areas and features of the Site are popular, and count visits. Most web browsers are set to accept cookies by default. You can choose to set your browser to remove or reject cookies, but this may affect the availability and functionality of the Site. For more information about cookies and how we use them, please see our Cookie Policy.
- d. **Third-Party Data.** We may receive information about you from third parties, such as social media platforms, marketing partners, public databases, and other external sources, to supplement the information we collect directly from you.

2. How We Use Your Information

We use the information we collect about you for various purposes, including to:

- a. Provide, operate, and maintain the Site and our services;
- b. Process your transactions and manage your orders;
- c. Improve, personalize, and expand the Site and our services;
- d. Understand and analyze how you use the Site;
- e. Develop new products, services, features, and functionality;
- f. Communicate with you, including for customer service, to provide you with updates and other information relating to the Site, and for marketing and promotional purposes;
- g. Send you newsletters, marketing communications, and other information that may be of interest to you, subject to your communication preferences;
- h. Process and respond to your inquiries and requests;
- i. Detect, prevent, and address technical issues, fraud, and other illegal activities;

- j. Comply with legal obligations and enforce our Terms and Conditions;
- k. Fulfill any other purpose for which you provide the information; and
- l. Carry out our obligations and enforce our rights arising from any contracts entered into between you and us.

3. **Disclosure of Your Information**

We may share your information in the following situations:

- a. **Service Providers.** We may share your information with third-party service providers, contractors, and agents who perform services on our behalf, such as payment processing, data analysis, email delivery, hosting services, customer service, and marketing assistance. These service providers are authorized to use your information only as necessary to provide services to us and are obligated to protect your information.
- b. **Business Transfers.** In the event of a merger, acquisition, reorganization, bankruptcy, or sale of all or a portion of our assets, your information may be transferred to the acquiring entity or successor. You will be notified via email and/or a prominent notice on the Site of any change in ownership or use of your personal information, as well as any choices you may have regarding your information.
- c. **Legal Requirements.** We may disclose your information if required to do so by law or in response to valid requests by public authorities, such as a court order, subpoena, or government agency. We may also disclose your information to enforce our Terms and Conditions, protect our rights, property, or safety, or the rights, property, or safety of others, or to investigate fraud or respond to a government request.
- d. **With Your Consent.** We may disclose your information for any other purpose with your consent or at your direction.
- e. **Aggregate or De-Identified Information.** We may share aggregated or de-identified information that cannot reasonably be used to identify you with third parties for marketing, advertising, research, or other purposes.

4. **Data Retention**

We will retain your personal information only for as long as necessary to fulfill the purposes for which it was collected, including to satisfy any legal, accounting, or reporting requirements. To determine the appropriate retention period for personal data, we consider the amount, nature, and sensitivity of the personal data, the potential risk of harm from unauthorized use or disclosure, the purposes for which we process your personal data, whether we can achieve those purposes through other means, and the applicable legal requirements. When we no longer need your personal information, we will securely delete or anonymize it in accordance with applicable data protection laws.

5. **Data Security**

We use administrative, technical, and physical security measures designed to protect your personal information from unauthorized access, use, alteration, and disclosure. These measures include encryption, firewalls, secure socket layer (SSL) technology, access controls, and regular security assessments. However, no method of transmission over the Internet or method of electronic storage is completely secure. While we strive to use commercially acceptable means to protect your personal information, we cannot guarantee its absolute security. You are responsible for maintaining the confidentiality of your account credentials and for any activities that occur under your account.

6. **Your Data Protection Rights**

Depending on your location and applicable law, you may have the following rights regarding your personal information:

- a. **Access.** You have the right to request access to the personal information we hold about you and to receive a copy of that information.
- b. **Correction.** You have the right to request that we correct any inaccurate or incomplete personal information we hold about you.
- c. **Deletion.** You have the right to request that we delete your personal information, subject to certain exceptions, such as when we are required to retain the information by law or for legitimate business purposes.
- d. **Restriction.** You have the right to request that we restrict the processing of your personal information under certain circumstances, such as when you contest the accuracy of the information or object to our processing.
- e. **Portability.** You have the right to request that we transfer your personal information to another organization or directly to you, where technically feasible.
- f. **Objection.** You have the right to object to our processing of your personal information for direct marketing purposes or where we are relying on a legitimate interest as the legal basis for processing.
- g. **Withdraw Consent.** If we are processing your personal information based on your consent, you have the right to withdraw your consent at any time. Withdrawing your consent will not affect the lawfulness of any processing we conducted prior to your withdrawal, nor will it affect processing of your personal information conducted in reliance on lawful processing grounds other than consent.

To exercise any of these rights, please contact us using the contact information provided below. We will respond to your request in accordance with applicable data protection laws. Please note that we may need to verify your identity before processing your request.

7. International Data Transfers

Your information, including personal data, may be transferred to and maintained on computers located outside of your state, province, country, or other governmental jurisdiction where the data protection laws may differ from those in your jurisdiction. If you are located outside the United States and choose to provide information to us, please note that we transfer the data, including personal data, to the United States and process it there. Your consent to this Privacy Policy followed by your submission of such information represents your agreement to that transfer. We will take all steps reasonably necessary to ensure that your data is treated securely and in accordance with this Privacy Policy.

8. Children's Privacy

The Site is not intended for use by children under the age of 18. We do not knowingly collect personally identifiable information from children under 18. If you are a parent or guardian and you are aware that your child has provided us with personal information, please contact us. If we become aware that we have collected personal information from children under 18 without verification of parental consent, we will take steps to remove that information from our servers.

9. Third-Party Websites and Services

The Site may contain links to third-party websites, applications, and services that are not owned or controlled by us. This Privacy Policy applies only to information collected by the Site. We are not responsible for the privacy practices of third-party websites or services. We

encourage you to review the privacy policies of any third-party websites or services before providing any personal information or using their services.

10. Marketing Communications

We may use your personal information to send you marketing communications, newsletters, promotional materials, and other information that may be of interest to you. You may opt out of receiving marketing communications from us at any time by following the unsubscribe instructions included in each email or by contacting us directly. Please note that even if you opt out of receiving marketing communications, we may still send you non-marketing communications, such as those related to your account, transactions, or our ongoing business relationship.

11. Do Not Track Signals
