21.11.25 Learning numbers in Blossom

21.11.25 Family Trees in Nursery



Conker Class have been reading 'Stick Man' this week. We went onto the field to collect sticks to make our own stick people. The children loved finding different sticks and discussed how they had managed to fall on the floor. They took the sticks back to class and made some stick people using glue, paint and string. The children then painted their stick man family and talked about the different people in their pictures. One child said 'we have a lot of people living in our family tree.' They counted 7 members of their family! We have asked the children to bring in their own family tree to share in class. Who lives in your family tree?




