WORLD BOOK DAY

It is World Book Day 2022 on 3rd March. This year the theme is **'You are a reader'** and we will take part in many fun activities to celebrate reading and our love of books.

Book Bingo

We will be giving all the children a 'Book Bingo' card with age appropriate book suggestions. When your child has read all the books they will receive a special Head Teachers' certificate.

FIND OUR VOICE!

Last year we were successful in our bid for funding from the LA Reset, Recovery and Renaissance Project. The RRR project was set up by the LA to support recovery projects in schools across Barnet.

Our project is called: **I can; You can; We can; Find Our Voice!** The main focus of the project is to build our children's oracy and performance skills through drama. Whilst being lots of fun, there is also a wealth of evidence to support the project, highlighting the positive impact of drama and oracy in supporting children with the verbal and non-verbal expression of ideas, and in improving attainment in reading, writing and maths and all subjects across the curriculum. With support from Orion and Goldbeaters, we will be working together to continue to bring fun and confidence back into learning and recover from the impact of the pandemic.

The project will be delivered in phases, each building on the previous:

- 1. Introductory drama workshops where techniques will be modelled to teaching staff to be used in teaching across the curriculum.
- 2. A Drama scheme of work will be developed which will enrich the existing curriculum and inspire children with a clear progression of skills.
- 3. A whole school drama and performance week involving the whole school community will take place during the Summer term.
- 4. Selected pupils will be given the opportunity to join the Orion theatre school and be part of their summer production.

We are really excited about the project and will be keeping you updated each step of the way. If you are interested in supporting us with the whole school performance in any way, please do let us know!
