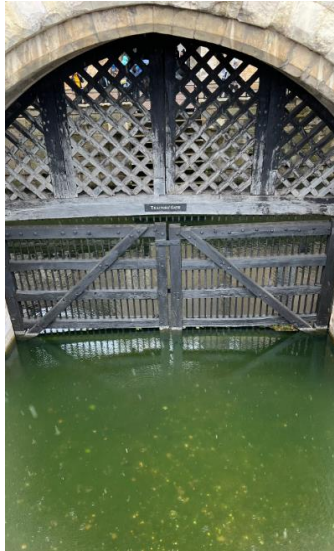

Overall, it was a great trip and the Year 5 children all were able to add a great experience to their learning of the Tudors.

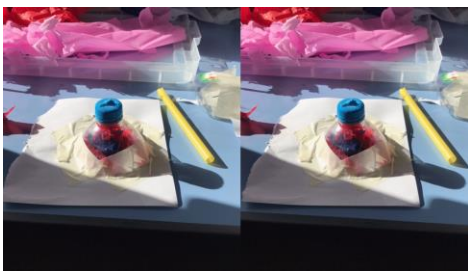


UNIFORM

DR BIKES

Dr Bikes are back in Barnet thanks to funding from Public Health and one is coming to your area soon. At the Dr Bike sessions, experienced mechanics check everything on an individual's bicycle from wheels, brakes, gears and tyre pressure to lights, racks, pedals, saddles and more.

Any minor adjustments can be made there and then, all for free. Anything the mechanics can't fix on site they will let the bike owner know exactly what needs doing and a rough guide to what it should cost at a bike shop. All the mechanics are friendly and approachable and have a wealth of cycling knowledge so individuals can pick their brains about cycle training or other cycling activities.

Are you a Barnet resident and the parent/guardian of a child under 5?

We would love to hear from you to understand your motivations or barriers to getting your child vaccinated against serious childhood disease.

Routine childhood vaccinations are given to babies and children of different ages, they begin when a baby is two months old. They provide protection against diseases including Measles, Mumps, Rubella, Whooping Cough, Diphtheria, Polio, Pneumococcal, Meningitis B and C, Hib, Hepatitis B, and Rotavirus.

Your answers will help us to improve our services for parents and carers throughout Barnet.

The survey is fully anonymous and will take about 5 to 10 minutes to complete.

All respondents must be:

- Be a guardian, main carer or parent of a child aged 0-5 years at the time of completing this survey
- Barnet resident

The survey will be collated by London Borough of Barnet Public Health Team in collaboration with NHS North Central London Clinical Commissioning Group.

Why join?

- Help to combat climate change.
- Did you know that food and farming are responsible for **35%!!** of global greenhouse gases?
- Protect wildlife by supporting sustainable farming practices.
- Eat healthy, tasty food and access veg you don't see in the supermarkets.
- Reduce your plastic waste.
- Support fairly paid jobs in the local area.
- Support GROW programmes and fight for food justice.
- Be a part of your local community.

How does it work?

- Select the size of veg box that you would like; small (3-4 items) or large (4-5 items).
- Prices start from just **£4.75 a week**. We operate an income based payment system which makes our veg affordable for all.
- Add weekly or monthly flower bunches.
- Pick up your veg from the farm every week during our pick up times. If you pick up on Thursdays, you can buy other seasonal treats at our stall and visit the GROW farm.
