#### HELP AND ADVICE

- Recent years have seen a continuing rise in the number of people whose lives are impacted by debt and money concerns.
- Bills piling up or falling into debt are likely to harm wellbeing. This stress could lead to sleep problems, low mood and possibly even physical illness.
- It is possible for you to take control of your finances budgeting and planning can help. If you can't manage, get advice. There's plenty of support available locally.
- You can claim Universal Credit to top up your wages if you are on a low income as well as providing help if you are out of work. It can also help with housing costs. This can be done over the phone if you are unable to use a computer.
- If you are looking for work, why not try out a benefit calculator to test how much you could be entitled to in different scenarios.
- You can still receive other benefits on top of Universal Credit for example PIP or Council Tax Support.
- It is always better to raise money issues early to avoid further issues in the future.
- Try to find ways to make your money go further for example furniture recycling centres, one off grants and foodbanks.

# Why join?

- Help to combat climate change.
- Did you know that food and farming are responsible for 35%!!
   of global greenhouse gases?
- Protect wildlife by supporting sustainable farming practices.
- Eat healthy, tasty food and access veg you don't see in the supermarkets.
- Reduce your plastic waste.
- Support fairly paid jobs in the local area.
- Support GROW programmes and fight for food justice.
- Be a part of your local community.



### How does it work?

- Select the size of veg box that you would like; small (3-4 items) or large (4-5 items).
- Prices start from just £4.75 a week.
   We operate an income based payment system which makes our veg affordable for all.
- Add weekly or monthly flower bunches.
- Pick up your veg from the farm every week during our pick up times. If you pick up on Thursdays, you can buy other seasonal treats at our stall and visit the GROW farm.
