
"I loved seeing all the different costumes," Zainab in Year 6 said.

# Free Early Years Education

Find out how your two year old can access 15 hours of early education for free each week.

All 3 and 4 year olds are entitled to 15 hours of free early education for 38 weeks a year. Some 3 to 4 year olds are eligible for 30 hours free childcare a week.

Working alongside Barnet Early Years Team, the Children's Centres can help check eligibility and support you in finding a suitable setting.
