YEAR 6 RESIDENTIAL TRIP

Year 6 children had the most incredible time last week on their residential visit to WildChild Adventures in Phasel's Wood. Children spent the week camping out in the forest developing their survival skills and knowledge of nature. Bushcraft activities saw children learning how to make fire and designing and building their own shelters to protect them from the elements. Children also became well acquainted with the variety of plant and animal life in the British countryside, identifying both edible and poisonous species by feature, recognising birds in flight by their silhouette and learning a number of uses for the wood, bark and leaves of different tree species.

Alongside this environmental education, children participated in a number of adventurous activities. Many overcame a fear of heights through abseiling and rock climbing, whilst the need for speed was sated on a toboggan run. The subterranean world was explored as children went on a number of potholing routes through the site and children's accuracy and focus was tested in an archery competition.

Throughout the week, the children were an absolute credit to Underhill, throwing themselves fully into new challenges and experiences and demonstrating an impressive adaptability and resilience. One aspect which was particularly noted by the WildChild instructors was how encouraging and supportive the children were of one another throughout all the activities. Any time there was a moment of nervousness, perhaps at the top of the climbing wall or at a tricky point in the cave system, other children would be on hand to offer empathy and motivation.

The trip concluded with a talent show around the campfire, where the children got to show off their range of skills. The sheer variety of talents on display was dazzling, with singing, dancing, sports, comedy and magic tricks all being showcased. It was a brilliant end to a fantastic week away and a brilliant example of how much talent Underhill holds.

The maturity and zeal which Year 6 have shown on this trip show that they are absolutely ready to face the challenges of secondary school. They should feel very proud of themselves indeed.


