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ADMISSIONS UPDATE FROM EAST BARNET SCHOOL

In accordance with the School Admission Code December 2021 Section 1.45, East Barnet School is consulting on its admission arrangements for 2024-25.

East Barnet School became an academy in 2011 and so therefore is conducting the requirement to consult fully every 7 years, furthermore it is our proposal to increase our admissions PAN from 210 to 220 students in Year 7 for September 2024 and thereafter. There will be no changes to the schools' admission arrangements for entry into the 6th form.
