Planned Road Safety Work on Mays Lane

Dear Parents and Carers,

Those of you living in the area will have received a letter outlining the planned changes to the roads along Mays Lane and the surrounding area. We are very disappointed to see that when the speed restriction is removed, there will be no controlled or Zebra crossing on Mays Lane or across Leaside as we have been requesting, and we are very concerned about the safety of families as they are arriving and leaving school each day.

We have spoken to other parents who share our concerns and would like to encourage other parents to write to the Highways Service to ask why there will be no formal crossing and to express your concerns. We have also spoken to Zahra Beg, the local councillor and an Underhill School governor, and she is also making enquiries.
