THIS WEEK STUDENTS WROTE LETTERS TO THE NEXT GROUP OF CHILDREN WHO WILL BE USING THEIR OUTDOOR FOOD GROWING SPACE. HERE ARE SOME OF THEIR WORDS OF WISDOM... "Have fun and don't stress. When planting you don't water the leaves or the sun will scorch them" "In GROW I've learnt so many things! I learned loads of facts, which I'm going to say: If you're growing beans, plant it next to corn so it can wrap around it. Give water to the soil where it can absorb the water by its roots." "I just love love love planting stuff. GROW is really calming and it awakens a hidden side of people I never would have known about""

WHAT'S NEXT? We are delighted to be welcoming all students to the GROW Farm for their final week. They will be able to get to know the TTA site, and see how food growing works on a large scale. They will also learn how to make fire and will toast some apples and marshmallows to celebrate the end of the programme! All schools involved in the programme will be continuing the development of their food growing spaces through extra-curricular programmes and after school activities from September involving parents, staff, and families. If you are interested in getting involved or learning more about food growing please contact the project lead at your school. Learning from the Land Learning from the Land is The Totteridge Academy's 3-year project delivered by GROW, in partnership with 4 primary schools in Barnet: Underhill School and Children's Centre, Whitings Hill Primary School, Foulds Primary School, and Grasvenor Avenue Infant School. This project is focused on the delivery of outdoor learning and wellbeing activities, connecting schools, and supporting pupils to flourish as they transition from primary to secondary. 15 pupils from each of the five schools a year will be referred into a 10-week GROW programme. In addition, each schools' outdoor learning and food growing facilities will be developed by GROW throughout the project for all pupils, staff, and parents to enjoy. 
