
ROAD SAFETY WEEK

FLU NASAL SPRAY VACCINATION FOR ALL PRIMARY SCHOOL CHILDREN

If you have not already done so please do not forget to complete the form sent by the Central London Community Healthcare team to protect your child from flu

The vaccination is free and is a quick and simple spray up the nose. Even if your child had it last year, the type of flu can vary each winter so it is recommended to have the flu vaccine again this year or they won't be protected.

The nursing team are due to immunise at our school on Thursday 25 November 2021. This year the consent process is electronic. In order to access the online consent form, please click on the following link



















YEAR 6

If you are in receipt of pupil premium parents can still receive a £50 discount off one instrument per child they enrol. Teachers can contact parents directly through the app.














SCHOOL PHOTOS
