FRED READING RESULTS


The FRED reads half way through this month are 9798

GROW

GROW project update.



This week we had our first taste of bad weather and had to plant in the rain. We checked on all the plants we had already put in the beds and these seem to be doing well.

This week we put in some Red Russian Kale plants - starting our brassica bed - and we sowed seeds. The children learnt how to make a drill by using a finger or the side of a trowel to make a line at the right depth for the seed. Into these drills they planted courgettes, broad beans, radishes and carrots.

We added labels to our existing plants and made new labels for the new sowings so that everyone will be able to identify the plants.


