COVID PROTOCOLS OVER SUMMER

If your child gets a positive PCR test over the summer holidays, please email us on <u>head@underhill.barnetmail.net</u>. We will be monitoring this email address over the summer. Please be aware that we may not reply to your email immediately. Schools are no longer required to carry out contact tracing. This wil be done by NHS Test and Trace, who wil be in touch with you to let you know about isolation periods for your household.

QUEEN'S PLATINUM JUBILEE

DROP OFF AND COLLECTION TIMINGS IN SEPTEMBER

EYFS and KS1: Staff will continue to meet the children in the small playground in the morning and take them to their classes. You will collect at the end of the day from the small playground.

Children in KS2 should arrive in the big playground and head straight to their classrooms in the morning. You will collect at the end of the day from the big playground.

If you have children in different key stages, your child will stay with their teacher while you collect siblings.

On the first day of term, Year 3 should go to the big hall, where they will meet their teachers.

With two teaching professionals in every webinar the model is safe and engaging. There is no limit to how many of your children can participate in these free lessons as pupils can access the lessons using any device.


