The Totteridge Academy and GROW are delighted to announce the launch of the Learning from the Land project

Learning from the Land is The Totteridge Academy's 3-year project delivered by GROW, in partnership with 4 primary schools in Barnet: Underhill School and Children's Centre, Whitings Hill Primary School, Foulds Primary School, and Grasvenor Avenue Infant School.

This project is focused on the delivery of outdoor learning and wellbeing activities, connecting schools, and supporting pupils to flourish as they transition from primary to secondary.

GROW works in schools and communities to promote mental well-being, physical health, and a more hands-on relationship with nature. We deliver curriculum, extra-curricular, and outreach-based programmes centered around food, nature, and well-being. Since launching our pilot scheme at The Totteridge Academy, North London two years ago, we have built a community farm, started a Forest School, and rolled out our unique curriculum to 300 students per week as part of the school timetable.

We are very excited to be delivering this very special project to all of your schools. We will send out a monthly *Learning from the Land* newsletter with updates, photos, and developments on the project.

The scheme is open to families in Barnet who don't have access to a safe open space or leisure facilities for their children to play and where they have a child/ren with special educational needs, learning difficulties or other challenging behaviour which prevents them from using public venues.




Well done to 9 classes who achieved the government target of 95.8% and a big congratulations to 1 Willow for 100% attendance!
