
The Reception day starts at 9 a.m. and finishes at 3:20 pm.

We will collect the children in the Reception drop off zone.

If you are dropping a sibling off at an earlier time you can drop your Reception child off at the same time.

Please enter the playground by the gate opposite the main office and follow the one way system. Please wear a mask.





If you are going to be delayed please let the school know as soon as possibleplease note charges may be applied for late collection.

If you need someone else to pick up your child please let the office or the teacher know as soon as possible. They will need to know the password that you have created.

We will dismiss the children in the same area as the morning drop off zone. Please allow us time and space to get the whole class outside before we start dismissing the children. Please wear a mask and follow the one way system.

#### **Uniform**

Your childs school uniform is listed on the school website.

- ~Yellow polo shirt
- ~Brown jumper (with school logo)
- ~Yellow checked dress (warmer months)
- ~Black shoes/plain black trainers

If your child is wearing tights or leggings under their skirts they need to be the school colours, grey or black. Not white or with patterns over them.

#### PE Kit


- ~White PE shorts

In Reception P.E will take place on Wednesday mornings. Your child should arrive at school wearing their P.E kit






# Messy Play

They are also entitled to a piece of fruit too.


Children will need to bring water to drink in a bottle clearly labelled with their name.



# Star of the Week








### **Phonics**



Here are the topics we will be using to inspire the children's learning this year...


Autumn 1- Do you want to be friends?	Autumn 2- Why do squirrels hide their nuts?

#### Home Learning


In Reception we will let you know the weekly home learning on SeeSaw (our online communication system).

Home learning each week will include;

- ~ Reading with your child every day for 10 minutes. We will allocate an early reading book at your child's level each week via My Rising Stars which is an online account for you to access our reading books.
- ~The sounds and words that we are learning in Phonics.
- ~ A fun activity to do together to support our class topic eg An Autumn walk.
- ~ An activity to practise the skill that we are learning in Maths.
