Dear parents/carers,

RE: Wallace Collection trip Monday 18th May 2026

Please note this is now the same day at the Stone X Athletics: children participating at Stone X will be going there, and not on this trip.

Throughout the course of the year we have looked at lots of artists and their works in Art lessons. On **Monday 18th May** we will be able to see some works of art in real life as we have been lucky enough to secure a *Landscapes and Seascapes* experience at **The Wallace Collection**.

“Explore the outdoors through landscape and seascape paintings. Your pupils will learn about the principles of composition and the use of perspective. Working with our museum educator, they will develop new vocabulary to understand and discuss landscape as a genre of painting. Inspired by artists such as Rubens, Canaletto and Salvator Rosa, your pupils will also create their own drawings.”

We will be leaving school around 9am and walking to High Barnet underground station. We will be getting the Northern line to Tottenham Court Road where we will change to the Central Line to travel the short distance to Bond Street. From there, it is a very short walk to the Museum. We aim to be back before the end of the school day, but will inform you by text message if we are running late.
