2.10.25 Reception self portraits!

We have displayed these in our classroom and have been learning about how unique and precious we are even though we are all different.

3.10.25 A busy week in Year 1!



We have had such a fantastic week of learning in Year 1. In English we have been looking at our sentence structure and rewriting the story of Bramwell Brown and his pals saving Old Bear from the attic. In maths we have been looking at comparing numbers and using key vocabulary such as less than, greater than and equal to.
