

Garden of Eden Church (GOE) Fellowship Meeting Information

To help you know what to expect when you attend a GOE church fellowship meeting, we created this information sheet. It's our hope that this will help avoid any discomfort or reluctance you may feel about being in new circumstances with people you may not know.

As in all things please seek and follow the Spirit's leading when committing your time to any activity. Our hope is to be able to offer this opportunity most Monday evenings at 7:00 pm. All are welcome.

In March of 2024 the GOE church held its first weekly Monday evening prayer meeting. Seen as a needed and vital part of our growing ministry to the nudist community, our desire is that prayer remains central to everything the church does while helping to build closer connections to living in God's will for our lives.

In July of 2026 the GOE church changed the name to fellowship meeting to more accurately reflect the broader scope this meeting has been bringing to the nudist Christians who have attended. At these meetings like minded Christians share community information, news and events, praise celebrations, and prayer concerns, all with a focus on Christian sensibilities. Every meeting ends in an opportunity to pray for each other and any other prayer need, identified or not.

To keep us from potential disruptions and distractions, this fellowship meeting is currently being held as an in-person meeting only in the home of Steve and Connie Bebell. They are active in the GOE church and offer the use of their home on the grounds of Lake Como for this and other church functions. Please contact someone on the worship team for the exact location. In the event their home is unavailable, this meeting may be canceled or moved to a different location.

This meeting is in an informal setting with everyone sitting around Steve and Connie's dining room table. Most people who attend are nude but nudity is not required or expected. Parking is limited so please be sure to let Steve or Connie know you wish to come so that parking can be managed. We will always figure out a way for you to attend if you are at Lake Como.

No one is expected to share or pray but the opportunity will be there for you. You can pray aloud or silently as you wish. No one is put on the spot to be performative in any way. More to the point is that this is a time we spend together as Christians with Christ's promise "For where two or three gather in my name, there am I with them" Matthew 18:20

All meetings open with prayer and close with prayer. Come be a part of a fellowship that sets its sights on things eternal, building relationships with each other, and growing closer to our Lord and Savior and his will in our lives.
