Absolution: The Lord Jesus Christ is faithful and just to forgive us our sins and to cleanse us of all unrighteousness; therefore we are forgiven! We are cleansed of all unrighteousness, and we are worthy to partake of this holy meal.

But I say to you, I will not drink of this fruit of the vine from now on until that day when I drink it new with you in My Father’s kingdom.”

Partake of the blood of Christ (Silent prayer)
