INTRODUCTION

This audit is not about tearing down what you have built. It is about discerning what naturally comes.

The **Purpose Pivot Audit** is a guided reflection designed to help you pause, assess, and realign. Inviting God to provide answers to those deeper questions of calling, peace, and purpose.



HOW TO USE THIS AUDIT

- Set aside 15–20 uninterrupted minutes
- Answer intuitively there are no "right" answers
- Use a journal or the space provided
- Pray before you begin, asking: "God, show me what You see."
