### Chapter 3

### Equity of the Nation (Teachings of Uno)

- 1. Uno noticed the injustice of Man in commerce and trade amongst the Nations abroad the earth. So, Uno decided to bring justice within the trade of the Nations by introducing equity. Uno gathered all the Leaders of the Tribes, Kings of the Kingdoms, Presidents of Nations to deliver the laws of equity.
- 2. There should be no departure from common observance or usage. No Man is bound to do what is impossible. From the words of the law One can depart. The absence of One who is employed in the service of the Nation, ought not to be burdensome to One nor to Man.
- 3. An absolute wrong sentence or proposition needs no observer, and abundant caution does no harm. An accessary will follow the nature of its principal; additions does not lead but follow its principal. No Man ought to accuse himself, unless before the Law.
- 4. Outside actions show inside secrets. An action is not given to One who has received no damages. A personal action is obsolete without the person. This must be understood of an action for a tort only. One ought not to hear who advances a proposition contrary to the rules of law.
- 5. The plaintiff must abide by the formula of the matter in dispute. When the plaintiff doesn't prove One case, the defendant is absolved. The act of One does no injury; that is, no Man is responsible for inevitable accidents.
- 6. An act already begun, the completion of which depends upon the will of the Man, may be recalled; but if it depends on the consent of a third Man, or of a contingency, it cannot be recalled. An act done by Man against One will, is not One act. An act does not make a Man guilty, unless the intention be also guilty. This maxim applies only to criminal cases; in civil matters it is otherwise.
- 7. Acts mandatory by law to be done, admit of no qualification. The act of the law does no Man, an injury. One bears relation to what follows next unless it destroys the meaning of the Truth. The One do not answer to questions of fact; Man do not answer to questions of law. The rough calculation of the value of a crime committed never increased from a subsequent fact.





- 9. To conceal is one thing, to be silent another; An alternate petition is not to be heard. It is to the intention that all law applies. The intention of the party is the soul of the instrument. An award is a judgment; Points of law are not laws. An argument from the greater to the less is of no force negatively; conversely it is.
- 10. An argument arising from a division is most powerful in law. An argument drawn from what is inconvenient is good in law because the law will not permit any inconvenience. An argument deduced from authority great avails in law. An argument drawn from authority is the strongest in law. An argument drawn from a similar case, or analogy, avails in law. A twisting of language is unworthy of a judge.
- 11. Natural equity or good faith do not allow us to demand twice the payment of the same thing. It is the part of a good judge to enlarge his jurisdiction; that, his remedial authority. It is the duty of a good judge to remove the cause of litigation. The good of a defendant arises from a perfect case, his/her harm from some defect. A good judge decides according to justice and right and prefers equity to strict law.
- 12. Necessary good is not good beyond the bounds of necessity. A fortuitous event is not to be foreseen, and no person is held bound to divine it. A case omitted and given to oblivion is left to the disposal of the common law. Chattels justly possessed cannot be lost. The immediate, and not the remote cause, is to be considered. Let the purchaser beware; Beware of fragments. The cause ceasing, the effect must cease. It is the crime which causes the shame, and not the scaffold?
- 13. A charter or deed of a thing not in being, is not valid. A deed or bond found with the debtor is presumed to be paid. Circuity is to be avoided. Unusual clauses always induce a suspicion. A useless clause or disposition is not supported by a remote presumption, or by a cause arising afterwards. No one is punished for merely thinking of a crime. No man ought to derive any benefit of his own wrong.
- 14. A common error makes law. What was at first illegal, being repeated many times, is presumed to have acquired the force of usage, and then it would be wrong to depart from it. The converse of this maxim is communis error no facit just. A common error does not make law. A confession made in court is of greater effect than any proof. A confirmation is null where the preceding gift is invalid.
- 15. The union of a man and a woman is of the law of nature. Consent, not lying together, constitutes marriage. Consent makes the law. A contract is a law between the parties,





which can acquire force only by consent. Consent removes or obviates a mistake. Those consenting and those perpetrating are embraced in the same punishment.





### Chapter 4

### The Honor of a Nation

- 1. A nation honor is built up on the morals, principles, standards, and the spirituality of the citizens of the nation. The leaders of the nation must fully lead by example to never lose the honor of the nation. The nation must be filled with Mothers and Fathers who are loyal to their customs, traditions, and laws?

### Chapter 6


## The Pyramid of Uno
