TO ESTABLISH LAWS OF PROTECTION AGAINST ARSON

Pursuant to the Moorish National Republic of Peace Constitution (2025), Amendment XVIII, Section 3, wherein it states:

"The Moorish National Republic of Peace shall make all laws necessary and proper for carrying out the powers vested in its government, departments, and officers under this Constitution,"

there shall hereby be designated Arson provisions to serve this purpose. This Public Law shall go into immediate effect.

TITLE I - CRIMINAL CODE

CHAPTER 4 - ARSON

Section 1. Arson within Special Maritime and Territorial Jurisdiction Whoever, within the special maritime and territorial jurisdiction of the Moorish National Republic of Peace, willfully and maliciously sets fire to or burns any:

- Building, structure, or vessel;
- Machinery or building materials or supplies;
- Military or naval stores, munitions of war;
- Structural aids or appliances for navigation or shipping;

or attempts or conspires to do such an act, shall be imprisoned for not more than 25 years, fined the greater of the fine under this title or the cost of repairing or replacing any property that is damaged or destroyed, or both.

Section 2. Aggravated Arson

Whoever commits arson as defined in Section 1, and as a result:

- (a) Places another person in danger of death or bodily harm, whether intentionally or recklessly, shall be imprisoned for no less than 15 years, fined, or both.
- (b) Causes serious bodily injury or death to any person, including a firefighter or law enforcement officer responding to the fire, shall be imprisoned for life or sentenced to death, depending on the severity of the crime.

Section 3. Arson to Defraud

Whoever maliciously sets fire to or burns, or attempts to burn, any property with intent to defraud any insurance provider, financial institution, or government agency, shall be imprisoned for no more than 20 years, fined, or both.

Section 4. Attempt and Conspiracy

Any person who attempts to commit, or conspires with another to commit, an offense under this chapter shall be subject to the same penalties prescribed for the completed offense.
