Supreme Religious Council Assembled PUBLIC LAW 111-07



TO ESTABLISH PUBLIC LAWS FOR BIOLOGICAL WEAPONS

Pursuant to the Moorish National Republic of Peace Constitution (2025), Amendment XVIII, Section 3, wherein it states:

"The Moorish National Republic of Peace shall make all laws necessary and proper for carrying out the powers vested in its government, departments, and officers under this Constitution,"

there shall hereby be designated Biological Weapons provisions to serve this purpose.

This Public Law shall go into immediate force.

TITLE I - CRIMINAL CODE

CHAPTER 7 - BIOLOGICAL WEAPONS

Section 1. Prohibitions with Respect to Biological Weapons

- (a) In General—Whoever:
 - 1. Knowingly develops, produces, stockpiles, transfers, acquires, retains, or possesses any biological agent, toxin, or delivery system for use as a weapon;
 - 2. Assists a foreign state or any organization to do so;
 - 3. Attempts, threatens, or conspires to do the same;

shall be **fined or imprisoned for life or any term of years**, or both. This section applies **extraterritorially** to any offense committed by or against a National of the **Moorish National Republic of Peace** (MNRP).

(b) **Additional Offense**—Whoever knowingly possesses a biological agent, toxin, or delivery system **without a lawful purpose**, such as medical research or defense, shall be **imprisoned for up to 10 years**.

Section 2. Requests for Security Assistance in Certain Emergencies

- (a) The **Jurist Council** may request the **Supreme Religious Council of Government** to provide security and enforcement support in an emergency involving a biological weapon of mass destruction.
- (b) The Supreme Religious Council may authorize enforcement measures to protect the people of MNRP and its interests against biological threats.

Section 3. Possession by Restricted Persons

- (a) **No restricted person** shall ship, transport, or possess any biological agent, toxin, or delivery system if listed as a **select agent** unless explicitly permitted by **MNRP law**.
- (b) **Restricted persons** include those:
 - Convicted of a felony involving biological or chemical threats;
 - Found mentally incompetent by a court of law;
 - Identified as an enemy of the state by MNRP jurisdiction;
 - Engaged in unauthorized foreign dealings involving biological threats.

Violators shall be **imprisoned for up to 10 years** or fined.

Section 4. Variola Virus (Smallpox) Prohibition

- (a) It is **unlawful** to produce, engineer, synthesize, acquire, transfer, or possess the **variola virus** or any derivative capable of causing **human smallpox**.
- (b) **Exceptions** apply to government-authorized research for legitimate defense purposes.
- (c) Violators shall be fined up to 2,000,000 Noble Dollar and imprisoned for not less than 25 years, or for life if the offense results in death.

Section 5. Seizure, Forfeiture, and Destruction

- (a) **Warrants for Seizure**—A **Jurist of the High Council** may issue a warrant to seize any biological agent, toxin, or delivery system unlawfully possessed or transferred.
- (b) **Emergency Seizure**—Law enforcement may confiscate and destroy such materials **without** a warrant under exigent circumstances.
- (c) **Affirmative Defense**—An individual may contest a seizure if they demonstrate a lawful, peaceful, or medical purpose for possession.

Section 6. Injunctions Against Biological Weapon Offenses

- (a) MNRP Government may file civil injunctions against:
 - 1. Individuals engaged in developing, stockpiling, or using biological weapons;
 - 2. Entities involved in biological weapon proliferation;
 - 3. Threats or conspiracies to engage in biological warfare.
- (b) **Affirmative Defense**—The accused must prove that the material was held for a **legitimate**, **peaceful purpose**.

Section 7. Definitions

For the purposes of this Public Law:

- 1. "Biological Agent" refers to any microorganism (bacteria, virus, fungus, etc.) or infectious substance capable of causing death, disease, or environmental damage.
- 2. "**Toxin**" refers to any poisonous substance derived from biological organisms, such as botulinum toxin or ricin.

- 3. "Delivery System" refers to any means of dispersing a biological agent, including mechanical, chemical, or manual methods.
- 4. "National of the Moorish National Republic of Peace" refers to individuals legally recognized as MNRP Nationals under the Repatriation Act.
