



# Men's Homeless Shelter

Males 18 years and older

Must provide Homeless Verification in order to schedule Intake Appointment (if exiting an institution, you would use your release/discharge documents)

Intakes are by Appointment ONLY during daytime

We do not accept drop-off clients

All client must complete intake and check-in process

All bags, backpacks, etc. must be stored in locker

## How to get a referral

- If you are living with a friend or a family member, that person can write a letter stating you can no longer live there. The letter must have that person's name and contact number.
- If you are living on the street, you can contact 211 for a referral. 211 will complete an assessment over the phone and email the agency a referral. Request for them to send a referral for shelter.
- If you are exiting an institution and your discharge paperwork shows you are homeless, must be date within the last 30 days.
- If you have a passport to service from TAD office showing you are homeless, must be date within the last 30 days.
- A third-party agency can provide homeless verification referral via letter on agency letter head
