A graduate of Stanislaus State, Carlos performed in a handful of shows as a Theatre Arts major. He portrayed the roles of Hector in **Roosters** and Frederico García Lorra in **Yerma**, as well as took-part in **The Jungle Book**. There, he'd meet Plato, the Ancient Greek philosopher who told the story of a powerful and advanced civilization called Atlantis and due to people's greed and corruption the city was destroyed in a catastrophic event.
