This year's theme is taken from Martin Luther King, Jr. speech, *Where Do We Go From Here?* The award amounts range from \$1,000 to \$2,500, and is given to students, ages 15-19, who have demonstrated leadership in the spirit of Rev. 

(A) In his speech "Where Do We Go From Here?" Dr. King spoke of transforming a neighborhood into a beloved community. Describe how you have worked, or plan to work, to strengthen unity and justice in your school or community?
□ Two Letters of Support: <i>Please submit as LastName_2026Reccomendation.</i> Please request and include two different, signed recommendation letters from school representatives, civic leaders, spiritual/religious leaders, or organization leaders who can comment on your accomplishments, and your commitment to social justice. Your recommendation letters may not be from the same person nor from representatives of the same organization and may not be from your parent/guardian(s).
□ Proof of Community Service : Please submit as FirstName_2026SVC.
Please provide proof of at least 20 community service hours from different organizations on their letterhead, including; the number of hours completed, the date and name of the tasks, and it must be signed by a representative of the organization. Your proof may not be signed by your parent/guardian(s).
□ Deadline - No Exceptions:
