Meet Results

The Meet results will be posted on Sherborne Storm website www.sherborneasc.com. These will be available in PDF and Hy-Tek result file format they will also be available on meet mobile. Results will also be passed to the ASA for their reference and inclusion in rankings.

Spectators

Entry to sessions is included in the meet entry fee, programs will be charged at £3.00 for the weekend.

Car Parking

Car Parking is available at the Oxley Sports Centre firstly for officials and is available on a first come first served basis.

Terms and Conditions

1. This meet will take place at the Oxley Sports Centre on 2nd and 3rd June 2018 and is licensed by South West ASA for entry into County Championships at Level 3 (Licence) it will be run in accordance with ASA laws, FINA Technical Rules of Swimming and the following terms and conditions:

1.1 This meet will be run in accordance with the permissions granted by the ASA, allowing level 3 to be run at the venue. Entries will be accepted on an entry accepted order (first come first served principle)

2. All ages are Age on Day as at 3rd June 2018

Age groups are: Male: 9, 10, 11, 12, 13, 14, 15, 16 & over Female: 9, 10, 11, 12, 13, 14, 15, 16 & over

3. Qualifying times (see separate table for details) the meet will be run as a level 3 licensed meet with:

Cut off times set below National Qualifier Standard.

4. All events will be run on a heat declared winner (HDW) basis. All heats will be swum with all age groups combined and swimmers seeded by entry times.

5. Electronic entries. For clubs with 5 or more swimmers entering, please email ssasc.competitions@gmail.com requesting the electronic entry files or download from www.sherborneasc.com Electronic entries are only accepted once payment has been received in full. All entrants are still bound by these Terms and Conditions of entry. Electronic entries are £5.50 per event. Clubs may pay by via BACS which is our preferred method of payment to SHERBORNE STORM ASC, Nat West Sort Code: **60-21-40** Account **67053327** Ref: Club Code June meet. Cheques made payable to Sherborne Storm ASC and crossed.

 7. Electronics entries from Hy-Tek TM or TM Lite Software should be submitted as an e-mail attachment to the above address and should include an entry report, fee entry report, poolside passes application and Officials list.
 8. Copies of the Team Manager Lite application can be downloaded free of charge from <http://www.hy-tekLtd.com/downloads.html>
 9. All other entries must be made on the forms provided and MUST include the entrant's ASA number. All information must be legible (BLOCK CAPITALS PLEASE). Entries that are incomplete, illegible or sent without the correct entry fee will not be accepted. All other ARE entries £5.75 per event. All cheques made payable to SHERBORNE STORM ASC
 10. Any entry not accepted will be refunded in full; no other monies will be refunded. All times shown on entry forms must be short course entry times, actual or converted to 25m pool. It is the responsibility of all competing clubs to ensure that entry times are accurate. Random checks will be made to the Rankings.
 11. With reference to condition 10 swimmers without times on the A.S.A. rankings database or the A.S.A. Masters rankings database, may enter using times (time trials) that have been achieved at events/locations that are not licensed but these times must be verifiable by their clubs. Entries with NT will be rejected.
 12. Refunds will only apply if the promoter has received written confirmation of a swimmer withdrawing before the official closing date or has been rejected from any swims.
- Closing date is **MIDNIGHT Sunday 29th April 2018.**
13. Entries will be accepted on a slow to fast basis. The promoters reserve the right to refuse entries to ensure the completion of the events within the time allotted and/or under Level 3 licensing restrictions. This will be done proportionately by age group.

14. Accepted/rejected entries will be posted on www.sherborneasc.com and should be checked for accuracy as the meet will be run 'cardless'. No details will be sent by post.
 15. Entries to this meet will be held on a computer and consent, as required by the Data Protection Act 1998, to the holding of personal information on computer will be deemed to have been given by the submission of entry.
 16. All competitors must be members of a club affiliated to the ASA, eligible (Category 2) to compete and registered in accordance with ASA laws and technical rules and may enter in the name of one club only.
 17. The competition pool is 25m in length with 6 lanes. Anti-turbulence ropes, electronic timing and placing will be used.
 18. At the referee's discretion, starts may be 'over the top'.
 19. It is the responsibility of the Team Managers and Coaches to ensure that their swimmers report to the Marshalling area in time for the start of their race.



20. Clubs entering more than 6 swimmers are requested to supply a registered official for every 6 swimmers in each session they are entering, however, clubs who unable to supply officials will not be penalised. The names, qualification level and contact details of officials should be sent to Kevin White, 69 Merevale Way, Yeovil, Somerset, BA21 3UW. Early notification would be appreciated.

21. Awards. Competitors placed 1st, 2nd and 3rd in each individual event in each age group will receive awards (HDW).

22. Coaches passes will be issued at a cost of £10.00 up to a maximum of 3 and 1 additional coach pass per 10 athletes over 30 swimmers. Passes must be purchased when submitting entries. There will be no entry to poolside without a pass and passes must be worn at all times. Coach passes will not be sold on the day.

23. PARA SWIMMING

The Sport of Swimming for athletes with impairment is governed by the IPC, and co-ordinated by the IPC Swimming Technical Committee, using the International Swimming Federation's (FINA) modified rules.

Entry will only be accepted from classified swimmers with British/IPC classification. Swimmers without a classification will not be able to compete.

Swimmers are allocated Exception Codes, which prevent them from being disqualified for rule infringement due to the nature of their impairment.

The procedure to identify relevant swimmer exception codes at competitions has been identified as follows:

Competitions which include Multi-Classification (MC) entry conditions - meet organizers will be responsible for having up to date information about each swimmer at entry and providing this to the meet referee.

NO QT is required but swimmers must have times recorded on British Ranking per event. NT may be accepted at the discretion of the Meet organiser.

All swimmers will be integrated into able-bodied heats.

24. The health, safety and wellbeing of all swimmers, officials, volunteers, spectators and visitors is paramount – all Health and Safety rules/regulations/requirements must be complied with at all times.

25. All swimmers, officials, volunteers, spectators, and visitors are required, at all times, to abide by the rules set out in the Pool Operating Procedures and/or the Normal Operating Procedures & Emergency Action Plan for the facility hired for the meet.

26. Unacceptable Behaviour - Behaviour becomes “unacceptable” when it is considered “Offensive” to others; this includes, but is not limited to, the following

Theft, wilful damage to property and /or equipment, acts of vandalism, abuse of alcohol and/or drugs, bullying, offensive language, aggressive/violent acts, threatening behaviour, all breaches of safety practices, failure to comply with instructions/directions, actions that bring the sport of swimming into disrepute.

27. Competitive Start Award Swimmers must have attained the standard of the Competitive Start Award in order to start from the blocks; (this is the responsibility of the club coach). Swimmers who



have not attained the standard of the Competitive Start Award must lower themselves into over the side into the water, on the long whistle of the Referee before starting at an appropriate place.

28. Jewellery For safety and security reasons, the wearing of jewellery is not permitted while in the water during warm-ups/swim-downs and/or competition. This includes watches, necklaces, chains, bangles, wrist bands, ear-rings (except studs), and rings (except wedding bands). Sherborne Storm Swimming Club will not be responsible for any jewellery brought to events and will not be liable if such jewellery is lost or damaged.”

29. Video and Photography, following updated guidance from the ASA the use of all photographic equipment is no longer controlled. Spectators / coaches and swimmers are reminded that if such equipment is used they should STOP AND THINK the guidelines on consent & decency must always apply.

Photography guidance applies to all images and recordings taken on any camera, mobile phone or other recording devices. Social media guidance will apply if those images or recordings are being shared through any social media platform [all club welfare officers have a copy of Wavepower where full guidelines can be found. These conditions may be overruled by the venue if they have a No Photography rule in place.

30. Any point not covered by these rules will be at the discretion of the organisers. Depending upon the situation, the Meet Director or Referees decision, respectively, will be final.

31. All participants must observe the safety precautions in operation at the Oxley Sports Centre this includes no changing on poolside or leaving the poolside without feet being covered.

32. Neither the Promoter nor the Oxley Sports Centre will be responsible for any loss or damage occurring during this meet.

33. Lead Referee decision is final
