

Our 2022 season is off to a great start (in spite of the first round being canceled due to winter storm Izzy)!

We conducted a training session for all current and prospective or alternate table workers on January 14<sup>th</sup>. We had 20 attend, which exceeded our estimate, and the session was very well received. Through this session we were able to fill open positions on all four tables and develop a small list of alternates to add some depth to our bench that allows us to fill periodic gaps in table coverage due to vacations or illness, etc. Thanks to all who attended.

At the session Claude Rhen shared his experience, insights and guidance regarding table operations as our primary instructor and we discussed a number of topics and issues of concern for table workers.

We plan to continue and improve upon this session annually going forward. If anyone has an interest in some day volunteering to work the registration tables for the tournaments, please let me know.

Volunteerism is at the very core of our being able to put together such an active and diverse golfing experience for all the members. I know of no other group (though I suppose they may exist, somewhere) that plays two-three games a week, over so many different courses, and at the same time offers as many as four out-of-town events and an annual tournament. ### Rambling from Tee to Green

Someone has gone to a great deal of time and effort to analyze our 2021 season and I thank you. A total of 87 pages of useful and eye-opening information are provided between the *Course Summary Report* and the *Member Annual Report*.

Why would a course want us to guarantee a minimum of 40 players per tournament when our average attendance at this course was 55 players? We had a total of 328 rounds at \$30 per round for an income of \$9,840 from SGAA. They made an average of \$1,650 every time we were scheduled to play their course. Makes me wonder if we did something they didn't like; or are they just feeling a bit greedy now that more people are getting outdoors once again.

The more informative and beneficial from a personal view; is the *Member Annual Report* as the name implies. The data gives each member an insight into how they played each course on our schedule.

For me I was surprised to see the results of my play on several courses.

One of my favorite courses to play, Bear Creek, hasn't been very good to me – I'm sure it's the course and not how I play it. Seems I played it a total of five times, my average score was just slightly better (93) than the group average (96) and I earned 2 rewards points.

Crystal Lake didn't surprise me as it is another favorite course and I usually feel like I play this course rather well earning 14 rewards points in two trips around the course.

On the other hand, Heron Bay hasn't been a favorite course. I have felt like I struggle on this course, but lo and behold Heron Bay has been one of my most productive places to play. Here, I've earned a whopping 26 rewards points averaging 6.5 points per round while playing closer (91) to the group average 92.

The more information pertaining to your performance that you can gather, the more your performance can improve. That is if you review the data and use it wisely.

If you look at the information for me on the *Member Annual Report* you can see that I can use all the help I can get which means I appreciate all the work that went into detailing the SGAA tournaments for 2021
