

We have a busy couple of months ahead of us as we prepare for the Annual Club Championship and Member Guest Tournaments. We also have very reasonable rates negotiated (i.e. \$149 plus tax for Saturday night and \$79 plus tax per night for Wednesday and/or Thursday night) for those who want to arrive early or stay a day or two after the tournament. I will include more details when we get into the 2025 season. Start saving your pennies and dollars now so you and your guest can take part in this special event. I promise that I will do everything in my power to make it a fun and memorable event!

Rambling from Jee to Green

Article IV, Section C, Paragraphs 4 and 5 of the By-Laws state:

- "4 The names of the appointed members of the nominating committee shall be made known to the membership at least two months prior to the Annual Meeting in order that members may submit, for committee consideration, their recommendations of candidates for office. All names for nominees must be submitted by September 15. Any member desiring to run for office after that date must participate as a write-in candidate. (R15)
- 5. It is the responsibility of the Board of Directors to place before the membership the approved list of nominees in writing at least one month prior to the Annual Meeting."

The members of the Nominating Committee are: **Larry Fauconnet** (Chair); **Jim Begnaud**; **Kerry Phillips**; and **Ted Pogue**. These men are the official nominating committee and they are looking for members to place in nomination for the vacancies that will occur at the end of this year.

We WILL be electing a **President**; a **Vice President**; a **Secretary**; and **three (3) members to the Board of Directors** at our Year End Banquet on Thursday, **November 14**th.

All of these positions are vital to the continuation and success of Senior Golfers Association of Atlanta – there's just one catch; they're all volunteers. Per the Secretary's Report we have a record number of new members this year. That means we have an abundance of new ideas as well. Yes, many past Officers and Board Members spent time working the registration table at our in-town tournaments; but that is not a requirement to run for office.

Although being a table worker is a very good path to take since you get familiar with both the membership and an insight into how SGAA runs; the ONLY REQUIREMENT needed to put your name on the ballot is to <u>volunteer</u>.
