

I have used this app for a full year and have recommended it to all my buddies. It is a great app! I would rate this app with 5 stars except I think it needs one feature added. I would like to be able to manually enter club distances. I sometimes forget to tag a club or I fail to finish the distance until I move to the next shot. I often know the distance, but just don't get it entered. Being able to manually enter my distances would ensure that I get more accurate club data. Please add this feature. Additionally,

the Apple Watch version needs some work. For instance, the app automatically goes to the scoring screen when near the green. However, if you leave that screen, to finish tracking a shot for example, there's no way to go back to the scoring screen. Also, there is no way to delete a tracked shot if you shank one and decide not to track it. If you have already entered the club, you have to delete it from your phone. In fact, I still have to keep my phone within easy reach, because the phone app version is so much more user friendly. I could not accurately score a round with just the watch. I would also like to see the Apple Watch version use its own GPS and not the phone's. I think this would improve the speed of the app since it's slower than other apps I have tried. One more thing. It would be nice if the Apple Watch version would automatically track a golf workout in the Workout app Please upgrade.

ANNUAL TOURNAMENT: This is a DOGFIGHT event and has 9 dates scheduled in September at the Monroe County Club Golf Course. It is stroke play based on gross score and limited to double bogey. Balls must be holed out on the



putting green up to one stroke less than double bogey. To determine net score, the player's dogfight handicap shall be deducted from his gross score.

YOU MUST HAVE AN SGAA ESTABLISHED HANDICAP to be eligible to play in this event and you must play a minimum of 4 rounds. You may play all 9 rounds as available on the schedule; but your best 4 rounds of the rounds played will determine your tournament score. Unlike other tournaments you pay a one time \$10.00 table fee on your first day of play and only pay green fees thereafter. If you opt to not participate in the Annual Tournament but want to join your friends to play golf, just notify the Table upon registration that you are not competing, and you will not pay

the \$10.00 table fee.

A PLAQUE, DESIGNATED AS THE SGAA CLUB CHAMPION, with the Winner's name and the year of winning, engraved thereon, will be awarded to the player with the <u>lowest gross</u> score. This individual will be the 2020 SGAA Club Champion.





THERE WILL ALSO BE FOUR FLIGHT WINNERS (Flights A, B, C and D) and points will be awarded for each flight to the <u>lowest net</u> winner. The number of additional winners in each flight will be determined by the Tournament Committee and will be limited to the total prize funds collected for the tournament. In the event of ties, winners will be determined by the player having the <u>lowest gross</u> score

for the four rounds. If still tied, the one having the lowest gross round shall win. If still tied, their cards for the first round played of the four best rounds shall be compared as for match play and the one winning the first hole, under the rules governing match play, shall be the winner.
