Greetings to all as we bid farewell to the 2024 season and eagerly look ahead to 2025 another year filled with good golf and fine fellowship. I trust everyone enjoyed a joyful and peaceful Christmas, surrounded by loved ones, and took the opportunity to recharge for the exciting year ahead. Here's hoping the new year brings new challenges, lower scores, and memorable moments shared among friends.

The 2024 season began and ended with lots of rain and several rainouts. We did play one round in December but our principal activity for the month was the last Board of Director's meeting. We had lots of productive discussions and I'd like to share a few of the results with you:

- Ron Wade and Tom Vardase proposed a new "Legacy" member status that was approved. To qualify, you must be at least 85 years of age and an SGAA member in good standing for 10 or more years. The \$25 annual dues for Legacy members will be waived starting this year.
- The 2025 SGAA schedule was approved as submitted with the understanding that some changes will be necessary during the year. We do have one new course (Dogwood Golf Course – Austell, GA) and dropped one course (Hickory Hills – Jackson, GA) on our circuit. The schedule has been posted on the website for your review.
- The in-town and out-of-town tournament committees are reviewing proposals regarding changes to the SGAA Annual Tournament and the out-of-town tournament schedule. They will review those and make recommendations to the Board at the next Board of Directors meeting.
- A few additions (e.g. drop zones on water holes and tee box adjustment for D flight players aged 90 and over) will be added to the Rules of Play.

I am currently in the process of reviewing and adjusting SGAA committee assignments for 2025. I'd really like to encourage our

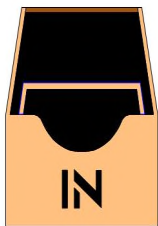

Welcome to another year of SGAA golf. It has been brought to the Board of Directors that there is some confusion as to the current rule for balls hit out of bounds. As per the SGAA Rules of Play here is the rule the association has approved:

BALL OUT OF BOUNDS, UNPLAYABLE or LOST- when a ball is hit out of bounds, declared unplayable or lost, after searching for a maximum of three (3) minutes, the player may place his ball **any distance along the flightpath of the ball where the ball went out of bounds**, is presumed lost or determined unplayable. A one (1)-stroke penalty shall be counted.

This adaptation is to help speed up play and is less of a penalty than the USGA rule. Thus, it is not where you find your ball out of bounds, but where it crossed out of bounds that you can place the ball in play. You can place the ball any distance **along the flightpath of the ball BEFORE it went out of bounds**. I hope the clarification clears up any misunderstanding of the rule.

While the weather in January usually requires extra layers of clothing, we have some excellent opportunities to play scheduled for the month. Looking forward to seeing you on the course.

Please continue to ask your friends and neighbors to join our group. Make sure the application is **complete** and **readable**.

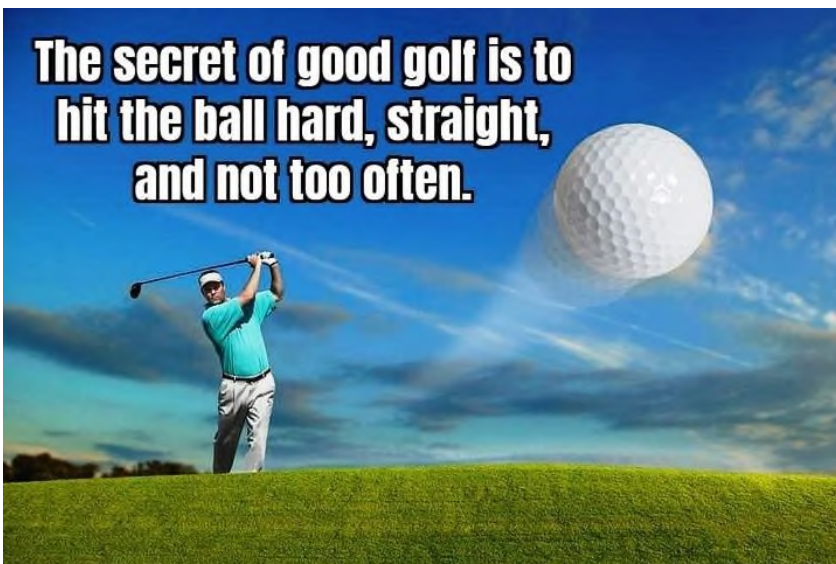
New applications should include a check for \$50 to insure membership.

Rambling from Tee to Green

The course lay before me, its greens kissed by the morning dew, each blade of grass a testament to the tender hand of time and nature. In the stillness of the hour, the game began long before I gripped the club or set my ball on the tee. Golf, I had learned, was a quiet battle waged not against opponents, nor even the course itself, but within the boundaries of my own mind.

The first swing, like the first decision in any endeavor, carried the weight of expectation. The driver felt familiar in my hands, its worn grip telling of countless rounds and lessons learned the hard way. I placed the ball and took my stance, the expanse of the fairway ahead both inviting and intimidating. It was not just a shot but a statement, a declaration of intent.

Doubt hovered at the edges of my thoughts, whispering of bunkers and water hazards, of missteps and mistakes. But as I drew the club back, I found a stillness within—a quiet resolve that told me to trust the process. In life, as in golf, overthinking is the enemy of execution. The swing, I reminded myself, must flow freely, born of preparation but unbound by fear.

The ball soared, cutting through the morning air with a clarity that mirrored the release of tension in my mind. It landed true, rolling gently to rest in the heart of the fairway. In that moment, I felt a surge of triumph, not for the outcome but for the process—a reminder that success often comes from trusting one's instincts, even in the face of uncertainty.

Each hole presented a new challenge, a fresh landscape of possibilities and pitfalls. The game demanded patience, resilience, and a willingness to adapt—qualities I found mirrored in life's own fairways and roughs. A missed putt or a poorly placed drive was not a failure but a lesson, a chance to recalibrate and try again.

Standing over a putt, the flag beckoning from a short but deceptive distance, I felt the weight of the moment. This was the culmination of effort, the point where preparation met opportunity. Yet, the smallest lapse in focus could undo it all. It was here, on the greens, that the game taught me humility—that perfection is fleeting and the line between triumph and defeat is razor-thin.

As I completed the round, I reflected on the parallels between the game and the journey beyond the course. Both required balance—a delicate harmony of precision and abandon, of planning and spontaneity. Both demanded resilience in the face of setbacks and the courage to take risks when the moment called for boldness.

Golf, in its quiet way, offered a space to confront the inner workings of the mind. It was not merely a sport but a meditation, a mirror held up to life's challenges and achievements. Each round was a journey, each hole a chapter, each swing an opportunity to learn and grow.

Walking back to the clubhouse, the sun now high and warm, I felt the lingering calm that comes from having faced oneself and emerged better for it. The course, like life, would always be waiting—its fairways stretching endlessly, its lessons infinite. All that mattered was the willingness to step up, to swing, and to embrace the journey, one shot at a time.

UPCOMING EVENTS TO LOOK FORWARD TO THIS YEAR

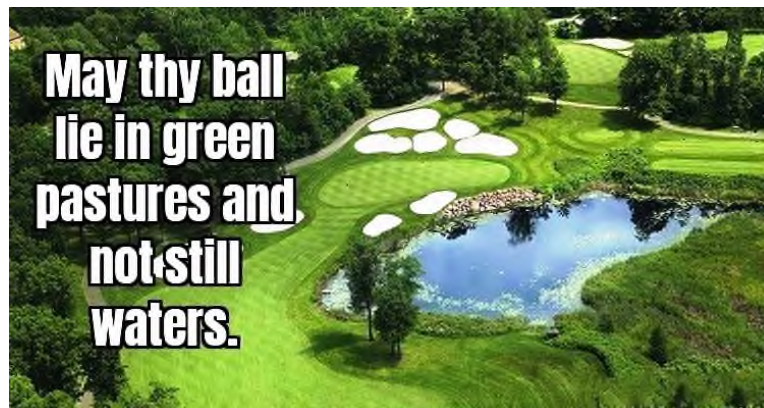

The Tee Off banquet is an opportunity to renew friendships with many of our members who don't get out to the course as often as they did; and a chance to kindle new friendships.
