9 In-Person Expectation Overview

@ Purpose

• Provide high-quality professional learning in a respectful and engaging environment.

(b) Attendance & Participation

Center Trainings

We are available to provide **custom trainings** either **off-site at your center** or **at our office**.

- \$ \$50 per hour (with a 2-hour minimum) for standard trainings
- **CEU trainings:** \$35 per participant (minimum of 8 participants required)

Training Certificates

- **Certificate distribution:** Training certificates are distributed to participants when the session concludes for most trainings.
- **CEU courses:** For some learning events, such as CEU courses, certificates are **mailed after successful completion**.
- Series trainings: Some trainings are offered as a series with additional
 assignments to be completed outside of the scheduled training. Participants must
 attend all sessions in the series and complete any assignments to receive the
 training certificate.
- Replacement certificates: Replacement training certificates cannot be provided.
 - Smart Start Rowan can issue an official letter verifying participation in a training within 2 years from the date of the training.
 - Please provide the title and date of the training and the participant's name.
 - The **first official letter is free**; afterwards, a \$3.00 fee will be charged.

X Cancellations & Refunds

- Participant cancellations:
 - You may cancel up to 24 hours prior to the training date to receive credit toward another training.
 - o A **substitute** may attend in your place.
 - Failure to cancel within 24 hours will result in **forfeiture of the registration fee**.
- No-shows / partial attendance:

 Registered participants who do not attend a session, or do not complete a series in its entirety, and have not canceled per policy, will not receive a refund and cannot transfer fees to another learning event.

• Provider cancellations:

- If Smart Start Rowan must cancel due to inclement weather, staff emergency, or low enrollment, your fee may be applied to another training or you may request a refund.

Medication Administration in Childcare

Participants will learn proper procedures for receiving, documenting, storing, and administering both prescription and over-the-counter medications. The training will also cover recognizing and responding to adverse reactions, communication with families and health care providers, and maintaining confidentiality.

By the end of this session, participants will be able to:

- Identify state regulations related to medication administration in child care settings.
- **↓** Demonstrate proper techniques for medication administration.
- Accurately complete medication documentation forms.
- Understand their role in partnering with families to ensure children's health and safety.

Lesson Planning for Infant toddler teachers
