


Four Paths

- **1. Make Your Impact Program** Discovery meeting, determination of non-profit alignment to your purpose and model, custom strategy preparation, four quarterly impact reports and communications recommendations.
- **2. Development Planning** formulating a strategic plan to achieve your philanthropic goals based on input.
- **3. Development Execution** filling gaps between staffing or fulfilling special projects or events.
- **4. Your Idea** doing the work you need when you need it and how you need it. This path could include sharing with your employees about what you have already supported and arranging an impact visit.

Discovery meeting for potential synergy, included, followed up by questionnaire about your philanthropic strategy


