AWANA begins on Sun, Oct 25 from 5:30-6:45 PM.

The AWANA program includes songs, games, Bible lessons and memory verses. The schedule is full of fun and activity while learning more about God's word and His direction for our lives. Our desire is to prepare kids to know, love and serve Jesus for a lifetime!

Parents can drop off their children starting at 5:20 PM and pick them up at 6:45 PM in the main church hallway. Parents are always welcome to stay.

During these special times of health concerns, AWANA will promote the CDC guidelines. Participants and staff will wear coverings when 6 ft. from children. Masks and hand sanitizer are readily available. Let us know if you have further concerns. Staff and students should not attend if they are ill or have a fever.

The AWANA clubbers will be preparing shoeboxes sent to children in other parts of the world as part of Operation Child with Samaritan's Purse. Later clubbers will collect coins for schools/orphanages in Kenya with Wilson Maungo and Baptist Missions.

Every session will have a "special" dress-up option. Students will earn additional points if they participate. Additionally, every month we will hold a SPECIAL EVENT with special games and activities! We will always have time for memorization and Bible lessons.

After attending 2 sessions, the students will receive a book that includes weekly lesson, activities that parents sign and a memory verse(s). Students will earn points based on completion of those lessons and memory verse preparation. As a group, each week the students will complete one section, with the goal of completing their book by the end of May. If students are absent, they may need to "catch-up" on their own.

Students will also receive an AWANA t-shirt, bag and if needed a Bible. They receive points for bringing/wearing their t-shirt and Bible.

Students also can earn points if their friends attend.

A couple special events will be held that parents are invited to attend. Currently, we have scheduled October 25, December 20 and May 23. Those events may have a special start time. More details will be available closer to that timeframe.

With any weather issues, we will use the church texting system to notify parents.
