

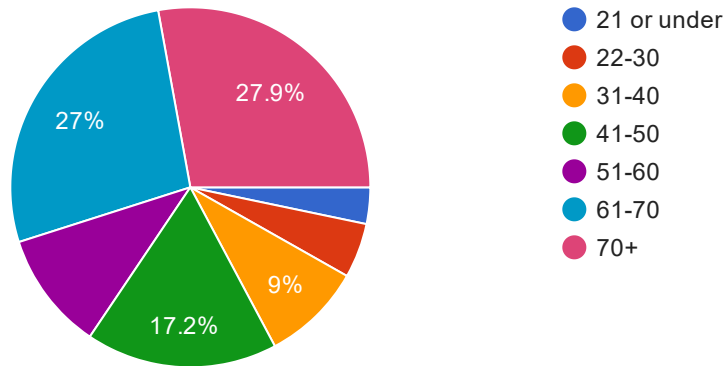

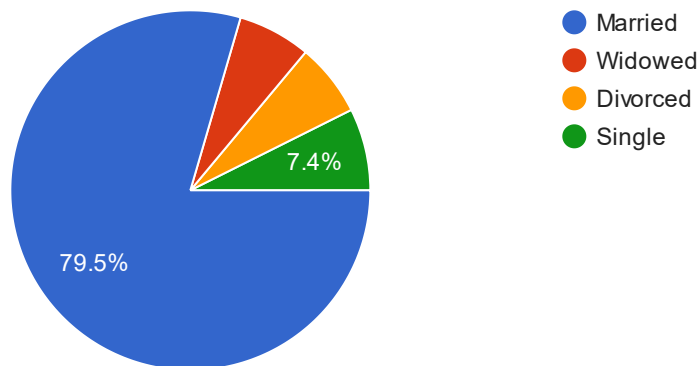

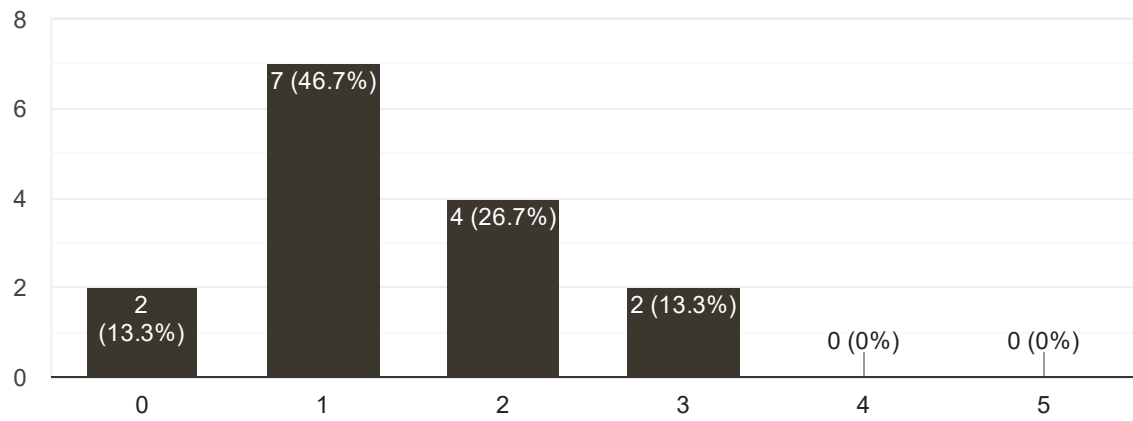


Your Number of Children at Home



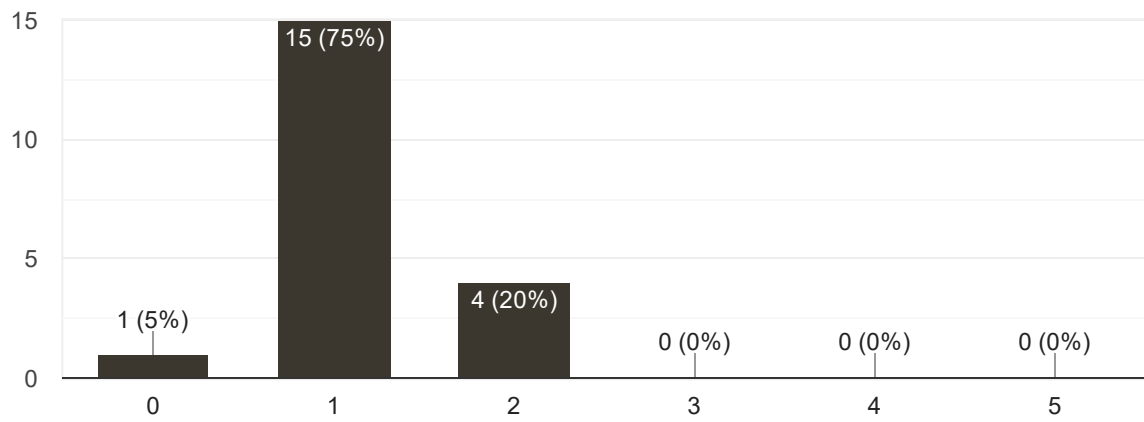

That we would continue to preach the "word" in truth - unashamedly!!

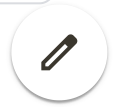
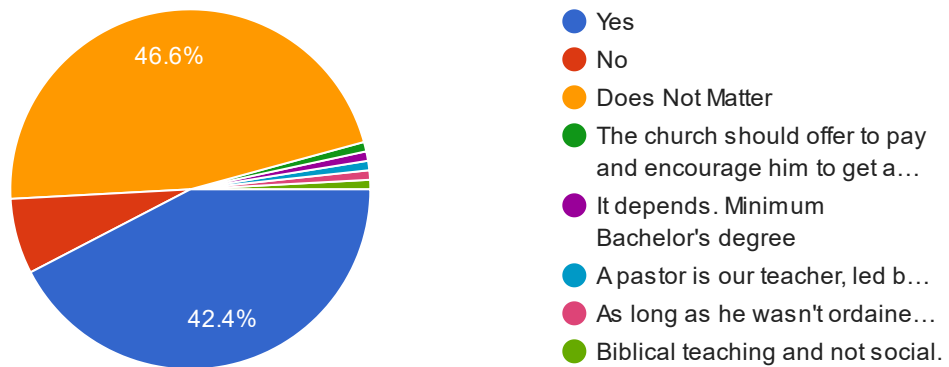

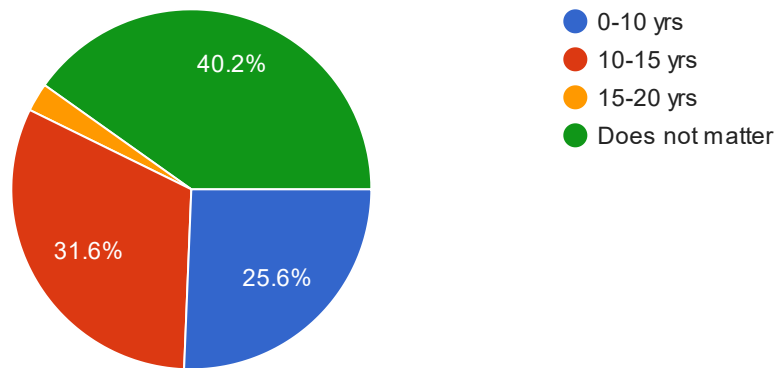

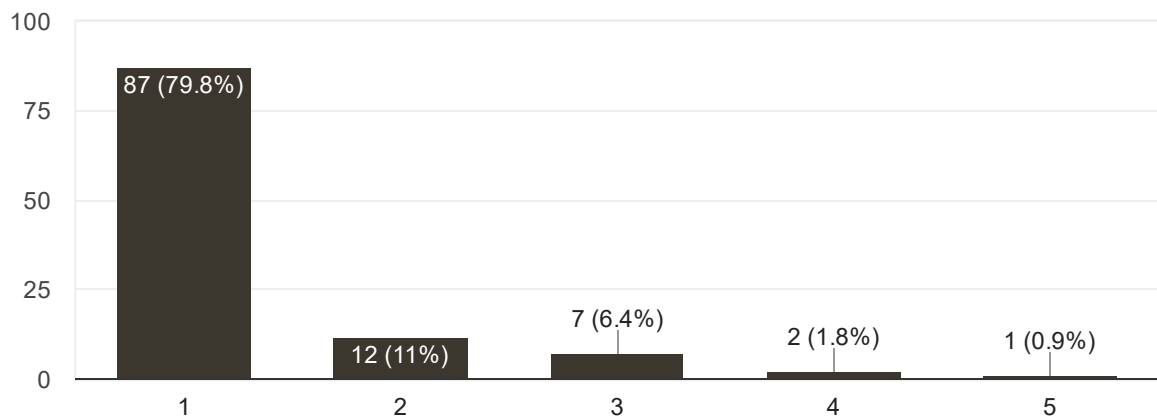

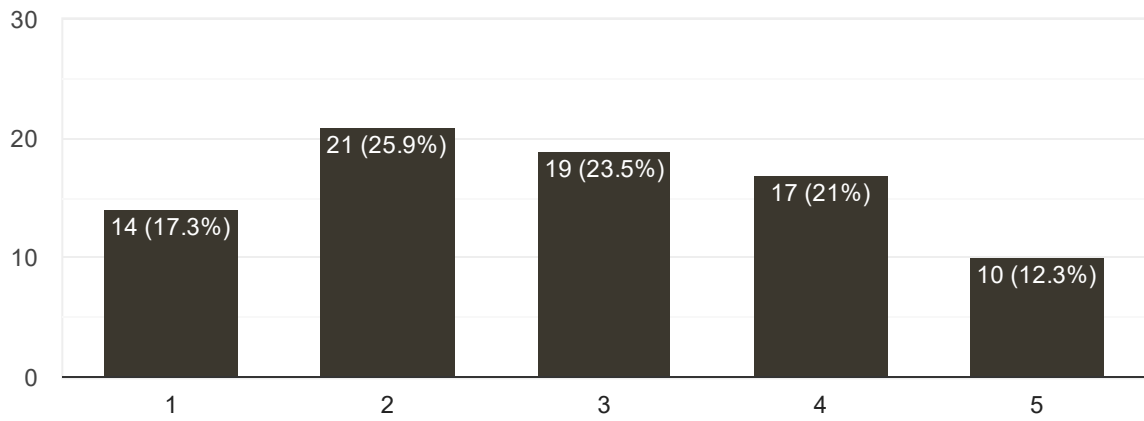
