

- Please read and understand all Wisconsin State and Salem Lakes Boating Regulations at https://dnr.wisconsin.gov/topic/Boat and https://ecode360.com/33348439#33348439
- No wake after SUNSET and before 10 AM − 7 DAYS A WEEK
- No wake within 200 feet of shore and 100 feet of any dock, raft, or pier
- A PWC cannot make a wake within **100 feet** of any boat, dock, raft or pier
- No wake during times of high water which will be posted at the boat landings by the Village and the Village website. https://voslwi.gov/
- Water skiing on Hooker Lake runs in a counter clockwise pattern
- The laws are now posted on the signs at the boat landings.

Please inform your children neighbors and guests of the boating regulations.



Warning: Blue-Green Algae can sicken children and pets!

Blue-green algae are in all water bodies in Wisconsin. Waters with high nutrient levels are more susceptible, but even lakes with excellent water quality may experience surface blooms. Please see the following link to identify Blue-Green Algae and learn more about it.
