

## Liberty Farms Farmers Market Driver and Assistant

[Liberty Farms](#) is a NOFA NY-certified organic farm in Columbia County, NY. We are a diversified farm on over 600+ acres, with about 12 acres dedicated to our organic vegetable and flower garden. We sell our produce, meat, eggs, and cut blooms at several local and NYC farmers markets, plus a growing CSA and several wholesale outlets including local restaurants and catering companies. We are seeking a Farmers Market Driver/Assistant for the 2023 season.

Due to the nature of this position, **the ideal candidate would either live in Columbia County or be willing to travel to the farm in the wee hours of the morning** in order to begin their day.

We currently participate in several farmers markets in NYC. We are looking for a personable early riser to reliably help with our two **SUNDAY** farmers markets in NYC: Domino Park (Brooklyn) and Stuyvesant Town (LES Manhattan). The Driver/Assistant would be meeting up with Market Staff in the city, and is mainly delivering everything to them while helping to set up and break down. There is a significant break built into the middle of you day.

### **Here is what your Sunday would look like:**

- 4am – Arrive at farm to load up van on your own
- 5am – Set off for Domino Park
- 7:30am – Arrive at Domino Park, meet Market Staff, help unload van
- 8:30am Arrive at Stuytown for the 8:45am escorted drive to market stall. (This one is in the middle of an apartment complex courtyard.) Driver helps Market Staff unload van and set up market stall.
- 2:45pm – Return to Domino Park to break down market stall and load up van
- 4:15pm – Return to Stuytown for 4:30pm escorted drive to market stall. Driver helps break down market stall and loads up van.
- 5pm – Driver sets off for farm
- 7:30pm – Driver arrives at farm, unloads van.
- 8:15pm – End of day.

**Please note: we may be including a CSA drop in Brooklyn on Sundays as well, which the driver would complete immediately after dropping off at Stuytown. The driver will take a longer break after all deliveries have been completed and before your return to Domino Park at 2:45pm.**

Requirements include:

- A valid driver's license and a reliable method of transportation to the farm, as there is no public transportation available in the area.
- A willingness to drive a van to, from, and within NYC.
- A strong work ethic and the ability to work well with others – a sense of humor is always helpful!
- The ability to lift 50 lbs.
- Experience working on a farm or food retail preferred, but not required.
- Spanish speaking is a plus, but not required.

Depending upon the market(s) you help out with, this position is open year round. Compensation is \$15.00/hour, plus a bounty of organic vegetables.
