MOONER BEACH

Recently, *The Seabreeze News* Division of Public Beaches did a little digging on a local beach named, Mooner Beach. What we found may surprise you. Mooner Beach had been a popular spot back in the 1970's and 80's, but has been completely neglected over the years.

While working at the Beach Pub across the street from Mooner Beach in the mid 2000s, Rhonda McCracken, a photographer at heart, would take the most amazing photos of the moon from that little beach. She also had several regular customers from the pub who would mischievously "moon" her from the beach while she was working. The name, "Mooner Beach" just seemed to fit.

Rhonda realized the potential that Mooner Beach had, and (then) Mayor, Kelly Abbitt prompted her to do something about it. With Mayor Kelly's guidance and encouragement, Rhonda initiated the effort and began the project in 2014. She reached out to local officials and applied for Texas State recognition along with Official State Guardianship, and the Texas State Adopt-a-Beach organization. She recruited volunteers, such as a local girl scout group to assist in picking up trash and debris, and asked friends and local residents to help bring Mooner back to its original natural state.

Roy Bryant was a big part of keeping Mooner Beach clean, he later became known as "Deputy Roy". He was often seen hauling trash from Mooner Beach to The Beach Pub. "Deputy Roy" passed away in March of 2020. (He is missed, and remembered well for his dedication to this effort.)

Rhonda moved away from San Leon and Dione Morrison picked up the lead along with the task of organizing and recruiting her best friends, Mikey and Cheryl Savoie, who willingly applied for and

## What is a house shut off valve?

A house shut off valve (pictured below) is a valve that's typically found on the side of your home where the water line comes in. While not all homes have a house shut off valve, it's a very important valve if you do have one: if closed, this valve will turn off all water service to the home! While this is handy to take care of any repairs you may need to address inside the home, during the summertime many people accidentally turn the house shut off valve when trying to turn off hoses or sprinklers. If you're experiencing a loss of service, always be sure to check your house shut off valve because it might be the culprit!

Fishing in Galveston Bay has been good, mostly small Speck's, Sheephead and Drum being caught.


Texas Parks and Wildlife finally finalized the ruling on Spotted sea trout for the state of Texas, it now stands three fish 15-20 inches per day per person allowing for one of the fish to be 30 plus inches in length.

Then on September 1st, a tag system will be implemented. The 30 plus inch rule allows for one fish per person per year 28 inches and longer, you will have the option to purchase a bonus tag, the three fish limit is the same.

It may be a big help to get a rule booklet that Texas Park and Wildlife puts publishes for FREE.

Be sure to take a kid fishing with you, they will always remember it!
