M.O.M.S. PETTING ZOO-BOLIVAR

The Seabreeze News division of "Mom We're Bored" ran across a unique petting zoo in Port Bolivar, Texas called M.O.M.S Petting Zoo. They are located at 900 Madison, just two miles from the ferry.

Brandon and Lynsey Kelly, along with their four year old daughter Willow moved to Bolivar in 2020 from Tennessee to help take care of Lynsey's dad. In January of 2023, they started building the petting zoo and they opened in May of 2023.

The name M.O.M.S, which stands for Mitchells on Madison, is a heartfelt tribute to their late father, Don Mitchell, who passed away in 2021. He instilled in them the importance of believing in themselves and making the most of life.

Upon our arrival at M.O.M.S., a Seabreeze News staffer was handed food for the animals, and off she went - I didn't see her for a while.

Each of the near 80 animals at M.O.M.S. have a name. These are not animals to the Kellys, they are pets. There are 40 chickens in coops and 9 free range chickens that roam the zoo. There is also a rooster "Bachelor Pad." Many of their pets come from Franko Funny Farm Sanctuary out of Baytown.

In residence are three adult pigs and two baby pigs. The baby pigs share a pen with Shelley, a large tortoise that is about 22 years old. All three cuddle up together at night. Among the animals is a donkey named Christmas, two male billy goats named Billy and Peter and three nannies that are milked every day.

The Kellys invite you to come make a day of it, they encourage you to pack a picnic and have lunch in one of the cozy picnic pavilions. On the property is also a little tike play area that includes a sand pit, swings, corn hole, large chalkboard and lots of toys. Who has time to be bored?

When Brandon was asked about hurricane evacuation plans he said, "The pens are built wide enough apart so we can just back the trailers in and load them up and move them to a family member's farm near Dallas."

Fellow Texan,



Now Texas has the opportunity to learn from their successes and challenges, and offer a program that best serves Texas students and parents.

Specifically, education savings accounts (ESAs) are the most ideal form of school choice. Under an ESA program, participants can use the money for private school tuition, tutoring, specialized programs and many other valuable tools. This will place parents fully in control of their child's education. Funding an ESA program does not mean taking dollars away from public schools. During the regular session, the Legislature made a historic investment in public education with the largest increase in public education funding in Texas history. This fall, we will continue to invest in the education of future Texans with an additional multibillion-dollar funding package that, in part, includes teacher pay raises, along with a robust school choice policy. The policies the Legislature will take up can make a radical difference for Texas teachers and students.

Further, school choice programs are widely supported in Texas. Independent polls conducted this year reveal a strong majority of Texans are supportive of school choice programs. Despite the narrative from school choice opponents, a recent University of Texas poll showed that 61% of rural Texans support some form of school choice program.

As a parent to four children, I feel a great responsibility to help spur the change our state's education system desperately needs. We must pass a school choice bill that allows parents to decide which education option works best for their children according to their values.







San Leon MUD Update

Galveston County Mosquito Control

Galveston County has a fleet of vehicles that are deployed throughout the county to spray for mosquitos. If you have any questions regarding spraying schedule or want to request spraying in your area, you can call them at 800.842.5622 or visit their website to see maps of the locations they've recently sprayed as well as where they intend to spray next.

What is a sewer cleanout?

A sewer cleanout is a PVC pipe and cap, typically 4" in diameter, that intersects with the sewer line that runs from your home to the District's main lines. It provides an access point for plumbers to diagnose and repair backups in the line that connects to the District's main line. It should be kept closed to function properly, as being left open will result in rain water getting into the District's collection system and inundating the wastewater treatment plant with unnecessary flow. If you have any questions about the location of your cleanout or how to replace a damaged cap, just call the office!

Some flounder are showing up in the Galveston Ship channel, that's a good sign fall is in full swing.


That means the Bolivar North Jetty will be a good place to give it a try. When the tide is right that's a good place to fish if you don't have a boat

they need to be included in your family's emergency plan. To prepare for the unexpected follow these tips

with your pets in mind:

Make a Plan

If you have a plan in place for you and your pets, you will likely encounter less difficulty, stress and worry when you need to make a decision during an emergency. If local officials ask you to evacuate, that means your pet should evacuate too. If you leave your pets behind, they may end up lost, injured or worse.

Things to include in your plan:

Have an evacuation plan for your pet. Many public shelters and hotels do not allow pets. Know a safe place where you can take your pets before disasters and emergencies happen.

Develop a buddy system: Plan with neighbors, friends or relatives to make sure that someone is available to care for or evacuate your pets if you are unable.

Have your pet micro chipped. Make sure to keep your address and phone number up-to-date on their chip and include contact information for an emergency contact outside of your immediate area.

Contact your local emergency management office, animal shelter or animal control office to get additional advice and information if you're unsure how to care for your pet in case of an emergency.

Build a Kit for Your Pet

Just as you do with your family's emergency supply kit, think first about the basics for survival, such as food and water. Have two kits, one larger kit if you are sheltering in place and one lightweight version for if you need to evacuate. Review your kits regularly to ensure that their contents especially medicines.



Animal Emergency Kit:

Food: Keep several days' supply of food in an airtight, waterproof container.

Water: Store a water bowl and several days' supply of water.

Medicine: Keep an extra supply of the medicine your pet takes on a regular basis in a waterproof container.

First aid kit: Talk to your veterinarian about most appropriate items for your pet's emergency medical needs.

Collar with ID tag and a harness or leash: Include a backup leash, collar and ID tag. Have copies of your pet's registration information and other relevant documents in a waterproof container and available electronically.

Traveling: bag, crate or sturdy carrier, ideally one for each pet.

Grooming items: Pet shampoo, conditioner and other items, in case your pet needs cleaning up.

Sanitation needs: Pet litter and litter box if needed, newspapers, paper towels, plastic trash bags and

household chlorine bleach to provide for your pet's sanitation needs.

A picture of you and your pet together: If you become separated, a photo of you and your pet together will help to document ownership and allow others to help find your pet.

Familiar items: Put favorite toys, treats or bedding in your kit. Familiar items can help reduce stress for your pet.

Tips for Large Animals


If you have pets such as horses, goats or pigs on your property, be sure to prepare before a disaster.

Ensure all animals have some form of identification. Evacuate animals earlier, whenever possible. Map out primary and secondary routes in advance.

Make available vehicles and trailers needed for transporting and supporting each type of animal. Also make available experienced handlers and drivers.

Ensure destinations have food, water, veterinary care and handling equipment.


If evacuation is not possible, animal owners must decide whether to move large animals to a barn or turn them loose outside.
