



# MOBILE "HIGH-RISES" GET COUNTY NOD FOR ELEVATION

Last month, The Seabreeze News received a "Letter to the Editor" about the growing number of mobile homes being set ten feet in the air, on cinder blocks.

Being the editor, I had to look into this and, well folks, you wont believe this, according to the requirements told to me by the Galveston County Engineering Department, all structures have to be a certain height, and that depends in which part of the county you reside. I have spoken to people who stated "the county doesn't care what you put up there, just that it meets the elevation requirements."

If you drive around town you will see many mobile homes elevated onto cinder blocks and tied down into non-compacted dirt. Some of these mobile homes are over 20 years old.

Let's face it, the average family can't afford a mortgage of \$400,000.00 or more. Many families are struggling with the current economy, and most low income families are struggling to put food on the table. So, what is the solution for our low income families to own a place to call home?

It is exactly what you are seeing now going up all over San Leon, people are buying lots with just enough room for a mobile home and maybe one car or truck. (This pushes additional vehicles onto the side of the road, sometimes

making it hard for emergency vehicles to get through.)

Some families may find an owner finance deal, leaving the choice for a used mobile home the best that they can afford and it goes ten feet in the air.

You may ask yourself, how does all this work with the county? The land owner draws up the plans for the property and if the plans meet the requirements set by Galveston County, they are issued a permit. Once permitted, the property owner can get water services, but they cannot get electricity until the county signs off on the building project.

Even with all these issues, there is nothing that can be done because this is an "unincorporated" area. As long as the land owners follow the proper channels and get a permit, they are allowed to jack that baby up.

These mobile homes will not stand up to strong hurricane winds as we had with Hurricane Ike. Falling over or being tossed into another home, could be a very serious and real situation. We are told by weather forecasters this will be a robust hurricane season.

If you feel as though someone is not following the law you can call Nichole or Michael with the permit department and they will come out and investigate.





When they get new tires or different tires on their car, leave the old ones at the tire shop and don't take them home. Nobody wants them.



# San Leon MUD Update



## Smart Irrigation Month

Yards can quickly die in the brutal Texas heat if not adequately watered, but overwatering can also drown the yard, resulting in shallow roots and decreased resilience. Most lawns only need about 1" of water per week to stay green and healthy. Place a few empty tuna cans around your lawn while you're watering and measure how long it takes your sprinkler to fill them with a half-inch of water. Then, try watering that amount of time twice a week, gauge how your landscape responds, and adjust based on weather conditions. Also, try to avoid watering in the middle of the day when the hot sun will evaporate much of the water before it can get to thirsty plants. For more tips, visit <https://takecareoftexas.org/water>
