

# 75 Year Prison Sentence for Galveston Stalker-Arsonist



Elias Charalambous

**GALVESTON** – Tuesday afternoon, a Galveston County jury convicted Elias Charalambous of arson after deliberating for just 15 minutes. The jury then sentenced Charalambous to 75 years in prison.

In May of 2023, the Galveston Fire Department responded to a fire at Lulu’s Hair Salon. An investigation by the Fire Marshals led to Elisias Charalambous. A week later, the fire department and the Galveston Police Department responded to another fire at the same location. GPD Officer Dontae Bailey interviewed Charalambous, who confessed to starting the fire. Charalambous was indicted for arson, a second-degree felony.

Trial began Monday, March 4th, with evidence which showed Charalambous set the fire because of his years-long obsession with an employee of the hair salon. Officer Bailey testified to Charalambous’ confession. Chief Assistant District Attorney Tyler Alley also showed the jury the body camera video of Charalambous’ confession. Assistant Fire Marshall Daniel Martinez testified that he determined the point of origin for the fire and concluded that the fire was caused by arson. Finally, the jury heard from the employee at Lulu’s who was targeted by Charalambous. She testified the defendant harassing her for years prior to the fire.

In closing arguments, ADA Alley argued the harassment of the employee explained the motive and context for the Defendant’s actions.

After returning a verdict of guilty, the jury heard evidence that Charalambous had previously started a fire at the same location ten years before, as well as evidence that he had been convicted of stalking for his continued harassment of the same employee. The jury also heard evidence of Charalambous’ other multiple prior felony convictions.

In closing arguments for punishment, Alley argued that Charalambous had made it clear that he was a continuous danger to the public as well as the victims. Alley also highlighted the fact that ten years in prison had not deterred Charalambous’ desire to set fire to the same building, and he asked the jury to keep him from doing it a fourth time. In Texas, if a jury finds the defendant has been convicted of two prior, separate felonies that each resulted in a prison sentence, the defendant can be sentenced 25 years up to 99 years or life in prison. The jury returned a verdict of 75 years in prison. The Galveston County Criminal District Attorney’s Office commends the Galveston Police Department and Galveston Fire Department for their work on the case.

Our U.S government employs about 10,000 Ecclesiastical Credential Chaplains who serve in all government agencies offering support for government employees. Chaplains push no religious agenda, they offer guidance to students of all backgrounds and beliefs. Their primary focus is providing compassionate care and fostering a sense of community and belonging within our schools.

Opponents who claim chaplains would not be certified professionals fail to recognize that the school board has complete authority to establish requirements for individuals to serve in this capacity.

# JURY DUTY???

*There is a lot more to it than just showing up.*

The law protects your job while you are fulfilling your jury duty and you cannot be fired for serving. Your employer is not, however, required to pay you for the time missed from work while on jury duty. (A good employer will pay you.) If you do not have a vehicle or do not drive, or you are unable to drive because of a physical disability, you can contact the Island Transit - Galveston Transportation Services at (409) 797-3900.

Island Transit, however, does not serve the entire county and you may need to make your own arrangements to get to jury service. You must bring your jury summons with you when you report for jury duty. In addition, you may want to bring something to do while you wait. Jury duty does involve some waiting, so a good book or hand work will help pass the time.

You may also want to bring money for snacks, drinks, and lunch. There is a break room with vending machines handy for snacks during breaks.

You may be selected for and actually serve on a jury the day you are summoned, so it's important that you dress appropriately. Jury service is serious business, and you should dress accordingly. Business attire is recommended.

Shorts, hats, tank tops and flip-flop sandals are not allowed. T-shirts with derogatory images or messages are also not considered

appropriate. When in doubt, dress seriously but with comfort in mind. Jury service can involve a good deal of sitting

Jurors are paid for their service. Each prospective juror sent to a court receives \$20.00 for the first day. If you are instructed to return to court another day, you will receive fifty-eight dollars (\$58) per day beginning the second day of service and thereafter until the trial has concluded.

Payment is processed at the end of the jury service, and a check is mailed to each juror within two to three weeks upon termination of your jury service. This could be a good side gig.

Each trial is as unique as the people involved, and there's no way to predict how long the trial you are chosen for will last. A trial can last a day or take up to a week or more. They are seldom much longer.

During the trial, the judge will tell you what time you need to be in court each day and what time to expect each day to end. You will also be given a break for lunch.

Free, uncovered parking is available in lots around, and across the street from, the justice center.

You can also be fined \$100.00 to \$1000.00 so don't ignore the summons. Besides it is your duty!

Don is on a first name basis with most of the local fish...





# SAN LEON CEMETERY RULES AND REGULATIONS

- The cemetery hours are from Dawn to Dusk.
- Loitering, playing in, soliciting, or vagrancy at the cemetery is prohibited.
- Due to the open nature of the grounds, The San Leon Cemetery is not responsible for any decorations damaged by elements, vandals, or by other causes beyond our control.
- The Cemetery Committee shall have the authority to remove all artificial floral designs, flowers, plantings and flags, should they become broken, unsightly, diseased, faded, dangerous or when they do not allow us to properly maintain the grounds.
- All Holiday decorations must be removed 14 days after the holiday.
- Limit solar lights to two per gravesite, and no farther than 12 inches from the headstones.
- All borders must be made of rock, stone or brick, must not be over eight inches high, and must be placed inside of your plot. No plastic or wire fencing as it prohibits the maintenance of the grounds.
- No glass containers are allowed due to the danger of broken glass.
- No planting of any trees or shrubs. You may donate trees or shrubs in honor of your loved one, to be placed where the cemetery deems appropriate.
- No decorating of cemetery trees, shrubs, fences, pavilion, or other structures.
- No chairs or benches are allowed unless it is on your plot.
- The Cemetery Committee has put these rules and regulations in effect to properly maintain the grounds and so all may have a respectful visit to their loved ones' gravesites.




