





## TEXAS CITY MAN SENTENCED TO 40 YEARS IN PRISON FOR ROAD RAGE SHOOTING DEATH

**GALVESTON** – On Tuesday afternoon, a Galveston County District Court sentenced Messiah James Pickens-McCoy, of Texas City, to 40 years in prison for the road rage shooting death of Gregory Walter Sharretts two years ago.

In the afternoon of January 26, 2022, Gregory Walter Sharretts and Messiah James Pickens-McCoy were each driving south on Highway 3 in Texas City. Sharretts and Pickens-McCoy stopped in the roadway. As they approached the intersection, Sharretts was in the left lane, and proceeded forward. Pickens-McCoy was in the right lane, and began firing several shots toward Sharretts' vehicle, and simultaneously turned west onto 25th Avenue North. One of the bullets hit Sharretts in the back of the head, and Sharetts' vehicle came to a stop. Pickens-McCoy continued to drive down 25th Avenue North. The incident was captured on video by a camera mounted in a car traveling behind Sharretts and Pickens-McCoy. The video clearly shows a hand holding a handgun extending out the driver's window of Pickens-McCoy's car and several shots being fired.

Nearby Texas City Police Officer M. Macik heard the gunshots and saw a vehicle travelling more than 100 mile per hour on Amburn Road. Officer Macik pursued the vehicle, but the defendant refused to pull over. Ultimately, Officer Macik caught the vehicle when it parked in a nearby apartment complex. Texas City Officers identified Messiah James Pickens-McCoy as the driver and his brother, Noah Pickens-McCoy as a passenger. Officers located a Glock 9mm handgun and empty magazine in the vehicle. They also located a spent shell casing on the vehicle near the windshield wiper blades. Pickens-McCoy pled guilty on Tuesday, January 23, 2024, and today, was sentenced by Judge Jared Robinson to 40 years in prison. The case was prosecuted by Chief Assistant District Attorney Raneca Henson.

The District Attorney's Office commends the officers of the Texas City Police Department for their excellent work bringing this offender to justice.

## What is a sewer cleanout?

A sewer cleanout is a PVC pipe and cap, typically 4" in diameter, that intersects with the sewer line that runs from your home to the District's main lines. It provides an access point for plumbers to diagnose and repair backups in the line that connects to the District's main line. It should be kept closed to function properly, as being left open will result in rain water getting into the District's collection system and inundating the wastewater treatment plant with unnecessary flow. If you have any questions about the location of your cleanout or how to replace a damaged cap, just call the office!






Not much to report on the fishing scene and now we are getting a lot of rain that will make our bay water very fresh, making trout move to deeper water.



- No glass containers are allowed due to the danger of broken glass.
- No planting of any trees or shrubs. You may donate trees or shrubs in honor of your loved one, to be placed where the cemetery deems appropriate.
- No decorating of cemetery trees, shrubs, fences, pavilion, or other structures.
- No chairs or benches are allowed unless it is on your plot.
- The Cemetery Committee has put these rules and regulations in effect to properly maintain the grounds and so all may have a respectful visit to their loved ones' gravesites.




