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# **DO YOU KNOW THE RULES?**

The Seabreeze News received a phone call and the lady stated she lived in San Leon, an unincorporated area of Galveston County. Living in an unincorporated area has its advantages and its disadvantages. She stated that she has a new neighbor that just lets his dog run loose while her

five dogs are in a fence in her backyard. When she mentioned to him that he can't just let his dog run loose, he there are no laws about turned and went into her house. Not only was the guy wrong for letting his dog run compliance with Galveston County dog Galveston County does have a leash law. Here are some other helpful facts that we found.

How many dogs can you own in Galveston County?

(a) It shall be unlawful for any person to keep, harbor, possess, maintain or allow to be kept, harbored, possessed or maintained, more than **three (3) dogs** or three (3) cats or a combination of said animals with the total number not exceeding three (3) over three (3) months old, upon or within any premises owned.

#### Is there a dog barking law in Texas?

Animal Nuisances. It shall be unlawful and constitute a public nuisance to keep any animal(s) that causes frequent, excessive or long continuous barking, whining, crying, meowing, howling, or other animal-related noise that interferes with public peace and comfort. Can you leave your dogs outside all day in Texas?

It is illegal in Texas to leave your dog outside without proper shelter in extreme temperatures. The Safe Outdoor Dogs Act, signed by Gov. Abbott in Oct. 2021, gives harsher penalties for those who chain their dogs up or leave them without shelter.

Can you break a window to save a dog in Texas?

Only eight states — California, Colorado, Indiana, Massachusetts, Wisconsin, Florida, Ohio and Tennessee — have "Good Samaritan" laws that allow any person to break a car window to save a pet.

#### Does Texas require you to register your dog?

The State of Texas requires rabies vaccinations for any dog or cat four months or older anywhere in the state. However, **state law leaves requirements for licensing pets up to the city and county**. What is the one bite rule in Texas? Who Is Liable for a Dog Bite in Texas?

Texas has an overarching one-bite law. This law can make it difficult to hold pet owners responsible for attacks. It requires the victim to prove the dog has bitten another person in the past or the owner had reason to know of the dog's vicious propensities.

#### How long before a stray dog is legally yours in Texas?

At least 7 days. If the identity of the owner is not known, scan the animal for microchip identification, provided the shelter, pound, kennel operating as a shelter or pound, or animal rescue organization facility has such technology available. If the owner is known, notice must be given.



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
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

We are in March and lots of specks will be caught, some under size and must be released. I'll try to give those that don't know the proper way to handle these fish so they survive and grow to be a legal size. Don't use a rag to hold the fish while removing the hook as it removes the muchneeded slime for its wellbeing. Get it back in the water as soon as possible. Keep your hands wet, use good needle nose pliers to remove the hook. If it swallows the hook, just cut the line as short as you can. It will most likely die anyway. You may want to move to another location if undersize fish is all that you are catching or you can bend the barb down using your pliers. We need to do all we can to protect all species of fish to ensure there will be fish for our future

generations to enjoy for years to come.

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# **TWDB Grant Funding**

The District has been in the process of obtaining state funding to help improve our sewer infrastructure. Our application was passed through administrative review and we're currently going through a technical review process, which may take several months. Once the TWDB has confirmed the data supplied in our application, the District will be able to finalize the funding to address much of the improvements needed in our aging sewer collection system.

# Water Line Improvements

For the past several years, the District has been working to inventory and identify key areas of our infrastructure that needs improvement, key of which are 2" water mains that are currently near or at capacity due to State mandated limits. Of the almost 31 miles of 2" lines, nearly half already of them are at capacity! Fortunately, since the wastewater plant expansion project came in under budget, we can reallocate the remaining funds toward improving those lines. The first phase of improvements should be awarded at this month's meeting, with the remainder undergoing design and bidding later this year. While we aren't sure the final date for the improvements to be fully completed, we're excited about the improvements that will be undertaken in the coming months and years to build resiliency and support for the future growth of San Leon!
