million spent on "mobile" generation (that every ratepayer pays for monthly at a 9.5% profit to CenterPoint) was nowhere to be found, vegetation management was inadequate before the storm, and leadership failed in getting enough linemen out for emergency restoration. Even though the actions and preparation of Center-Point's management failed, they will continue

their mistakes. This is unacceptable.

You also have to ask what's the point of smart meters if they can't alert us which meters are on and which critical facilities don't have power. Only 42% of customers receive power outage updates through CenterPoint's system. When I

to charge ratepayers even more for the cost of asked the CenterPoint CEO if they attempted to get customer contact information for the other 58%, he lied and said he asked for the information and never received it. Sincerely,

Galveston County Health District urges caution due to rising cases of Vibrio Bacteria related Illnesses

GALVESTON COUNTY, Texas —

Galveston County Health District (GCHD) is issuing an important public health alert regarding Vibrio bacteria, a group of bacteria commonly found in marine environments. Galveston County Health District has been working closely with UTMB due to an increase of Vibrio cases this year. Recent reports of Vibrio infections have raised concerns about the potential health risks associated with exposure to these bacteria, especially during the summer when water activities peak.

Overview of Vibrio Bacteria

Vibrio are naturally found in warm coastal seawater around the world. The bacteria are present throughout the year but are more prevalent in summer when the water is warmer. Vibrio cholerae, Vibrio parahaemolyticus, and Vibrio vulnificus are the most common species responsible for infections. "While Vibrio bacteria can be present in Galveston waters, there's no need to panic. Use common sense: avoid raw seafood, practice good hygiene, and stay informed to keep safe." Dr. Phillip Keiser, the Local Health Authority and CEO of the Galveston County Health District, said. Statistics show it's rare for a person to develop a severe infection from Vibrio bacteria. When such infections occur, it's common for the affected person to have preexisting immune-suppressing health conditions and open sores or wounds.

Recent Outbreaks

Recent surveillance has identified an increase in Vibrio-related cases from Galveston Beach. The majority of reported cases involve severe wound infections from Vibrio vulnificus, with a few gastrointestinal illnesses from Vibrio parahaemolyticus and cholera-related illnesses from Vibrio cholera. Health officials are working diligently to investigate the sources of these infections and implement measures to prevent further cases.

Symptoms and Risks

Symptoms of Vibrio infections can vary depending on the species:

Vibrio cholerae: Causes cholera, which is characterized by severe diarrhea, vomiting, and dehydration.

Vibrio parahaemolyticus: This leads to gastroenteritis with symptoms such as diarrhea, abdominal cramps, nausea, and vomiting.

Vibrio vulnificus: Can cause wound infections, which may lead to severe complications or even be life-threatening, especially in individuals with weakened immune systems or liver disease.

Preventive Measures

To protect yourself and others from Vibrio infections, the Health Organization recommends the following precautions:

Avoid Raw or Undercooked Seafood: Ensure seafood is cooked thoroughly before consumption. Avoid eating raw shellfish, especially from areas with reported Vibrio outbreaks.

Practice Good Hygiene: Wash hands thoroughly with soap and water, particularly after handling raw seafood.

Protect Wounds: Keep any cuts or open wounds covered and avoid exposure to seawater if you have an open wound.

Stay Informed: Pay attention to local health advisories regarding water quality and seafood safety.

What to Do If You Suspect an Infection

If you experience symptoms consistent with a Vibrio infection, such as severe gastrointestinal distress or wound infections following exposure to seawater, seek medical attention promptly. Early diagnosis and treatment are crucial to managing symptoms and preventing complications.

The Health District is committed to safeguarding public health and collaborating with local health departments and marine authorities to address this issue. We urge the public to follow the recommended preventive measures and to remain vigilant during the summer months.
