HURRICANE SEASON IS HERE, ARE YOU READY?

There are many things you need to consider doing during hurricane season:

- Keep your gas tanks topped off, so when the officials call for an evacuation, you need to be ready to go. There will be long lines at gas stations, and it's possible they may run out of gas.
- Have all your important papers in a tote; you will want to take birth certificates, marriage certificates, medical information and any insurance papers along with photos of your home and property.
- Make sure you have good flashlights along with new batteries, and that all important phone charger.
- Water and food should be stocked up for three or four day. You should have one gallon of water per person/per day. You will also need a manual can opener unless you buy all pull tab cans.
- You never know what will happen or where you

will end up unless you make plans prior to evacuation. Pack mosquito spray and have a first aid kit on hand.

- Pack plenty of clothing for you and your family, and sensible shoes.
- Pack toys for the kids, you may end up in the car for hours. A fun thing to do is bring a wind up alarm clock and when they start to get restless make the alarm go off and it could be snack time or exchange game time. This will not be a fun trip, make the best of it.
- Let's not forget about pets. Make sure you have enough food and water for them along with their blankets and toys

Please check on your elderly neighbors. See if you can help them plan and prepare for any events that might put them in harm's way!

Fellow Texan,

This past week, the Texas Senate State Affairs Committee held a hearing on keeping our elections secure and protecting Texas land from adversarial foreign investments.

We heard unsettling testimony from Google and Facebook whistle blowers and other tech experts detailing how Big Tech is using their near monopolistic hold over the Internet to interfere in our elections. Additional testimony was heard concerning attempts by hostile foreign nations, such as China, Iran, Russia, and North Korea, to purchase land in our state. Last session the Texas Senate passed SB 147, a bill that would have banned governments or citizens of adversarial nations from purchasing property in Texas. Unfortunately the House failed to take up the bill and it died in committee. As a Joint Author of SB 147, I take this issue very seriously.

During the course of the hearing I raised the issue of how the Chinese government used WeChat, a Communist Chinese Party controlled social media platform, to try and pressure members of legislature into voting the bill down.

San Leon MUD Update

Hurricane Season

There have been a number of new folks moving to San Leon, so for those not in the know, hurricane season is here! Atlantic hurricane season begins June 1st and lasts until November 30th, with peak season from mid-August to late October. Galveston County Office of Emergency Management (GCOEM), has several resources available on its website, www.gcoem.org, including preparation guides for adults and kids, as well as links to sign up for the State of Texas Emergency Assistance Registry, a free registry that provides local emergency planners and emergency responders with additional information on the needs in the community.

Brush Bundling & Debris Removal

With hurricane season here, be sure to clean up your property, removing any debris that may block drainage or become projectiles in the event of high winds. While Galveston County is not responsible for picking up brush or debris, Texas Pride will pick up brush that's placed in clear, individual piles measuring no larger than 3' x 3' x 3' or tied and bundled and under 50 pounds.

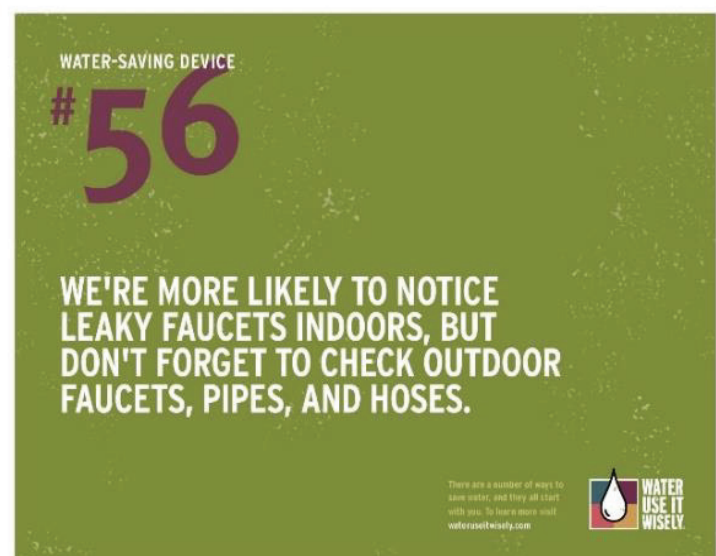

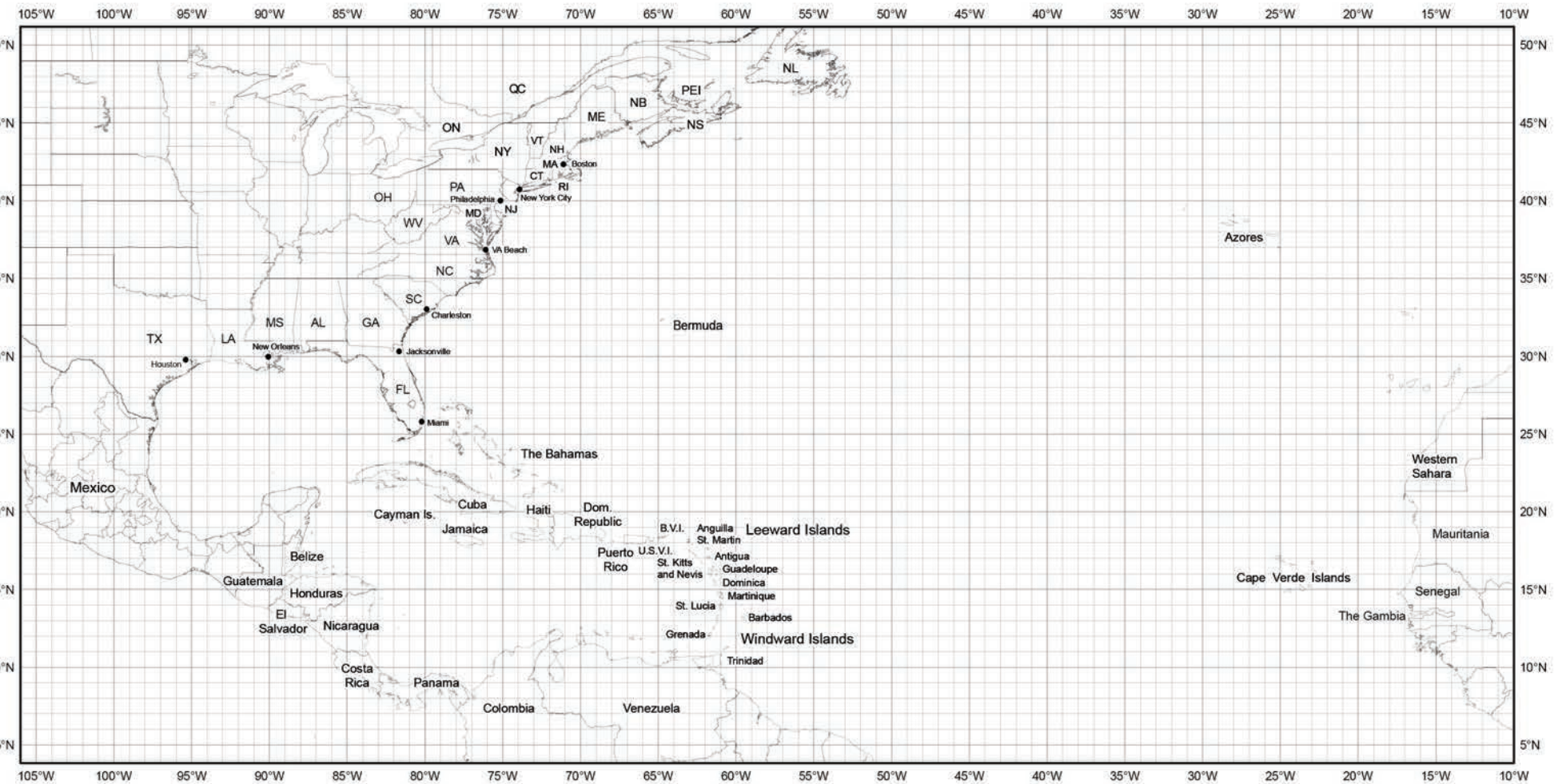

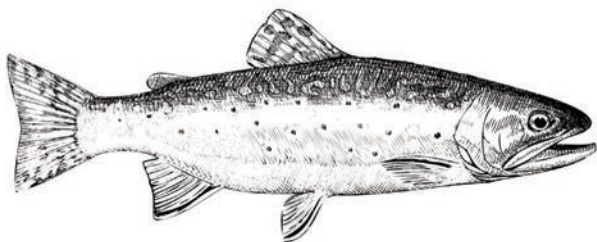
San Leon Don's FISHING TIPS

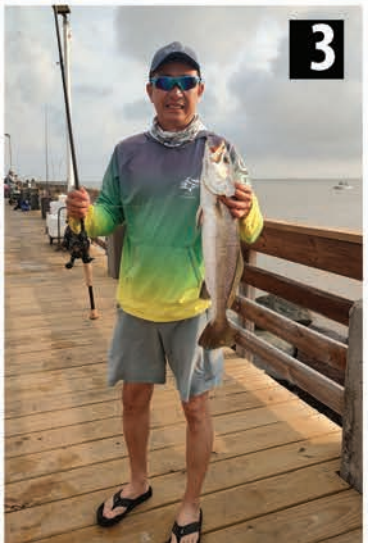

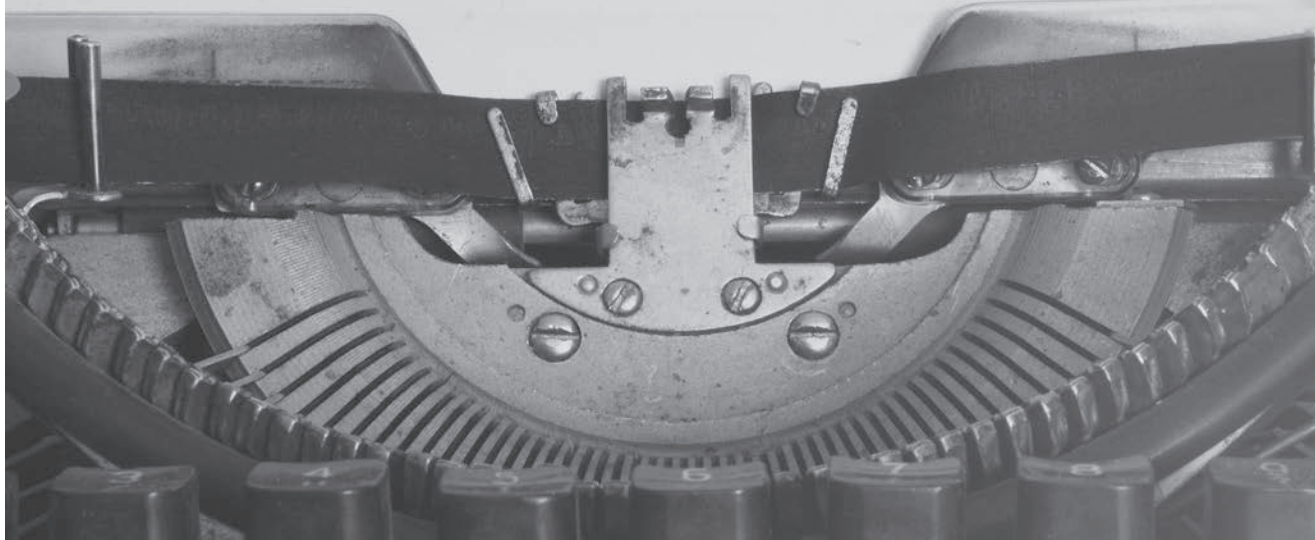

Dear Editor,

I believe mobile homes high up on cinder blocks are trouble looking for a place to happen. Those of us who have lived here for years, understand why these are nothing but TROUBLE! Strong winds can, and will cause them to self-destruct. If one is erected next to a home and falls to pieces in a storm, it could very well wind up in your living room. A lot of these "pieces of junk" are reworked motor homes which have no chance against hurricane force winds.

They should not have utilities at ten feet in the air on cinder blocks with anchors that screw into the ground or go through two or three feet of non-compacted soil.

Building and living quarters on a 25 ft lot should not be allowed, there is no room for parking cars which leads to parking on the street. Neighbors have reported seeing fire trucks trying to get to an address where needed, only to have to back out and take a new route to get to the fire.

When a storm takes these pieces of crap out, will the owners end up with a new FEMA home? These people that are questioning new rulings are people that have been through several hurricanes and know what they can do.
