family functions or outings with friends. You may witness jealousy and controlling tendencies between the couple.

Back in the day, people said "that's none of my business or I'm not getting involved." Most people still think that way. If you care about that person, make it your business and get involved, but not to the point that you put yourself in harm's way.

If you are in a domestic violence relationship, when your abuser hits you, call the cops! Follow through with the advice that the police give you. If your abuser goes to jail, that is your time to get your belongings and GET OUT! Especially If you have kids, grab them and go! Do not let your children think that is a tolerated behavior. You may not have any friends or family left that want to deal with the situation any more, but there are shelters. If you keep calling the cops everytime you are hit by your abuser, after a while the cops get numb to your situation, your family and friends already gave up and now the cops have. When the cops get the call and it's your address again they will say, well Bob and Sally are at it again.

In most cases your life is in danger. You may tell yourself "he just pushes me around every now and then" well what about that last time your abuser pushes you and you hit your head just right on the fireplace? If you make it out of that relationship, go! Don't look back! You may tell yourself, "well they love me..." Don't let someone love you to death!

Please don't be that person that says, "I knew there was something wrong with that couple," as the coroner is taking a body out of your neighbors house, or "I knew my family was in a bad relationship, but I didn't know it was that bad," as you are making funeral arrangements.

BABY MOSES LAW: PROTECTING YOU AND YOUR CHILD



"...You have the option to bring your baby to a designated safe place with no questions asked."

If you have a newborn that you are unable to care for, you have the option to bring your baby to a designated safe place with no questions asked. The Safe Haven Law, also known as the "Baby Moses Law," provides parents with a safe and legal choice to leave their infant with an employee at a designated safe place, such as a hospital, fire station, free-standing emergency center, or emergency medical services (EMS) station. Once there, your baby will receive medical care and be placed with an emergency provider.

If you are considering bringing your baby to a Safe Haven, here is some important information to keep in mind: Your baby must be 60 days old or younger, unharmed, and safe. You can take your baby to any hospital, fire station, or EMS station in Texas. When you arrive, you need to give your baby to an employee who works at one of these safe places and inform them that you wish to leave your baby at a Safe Haven.

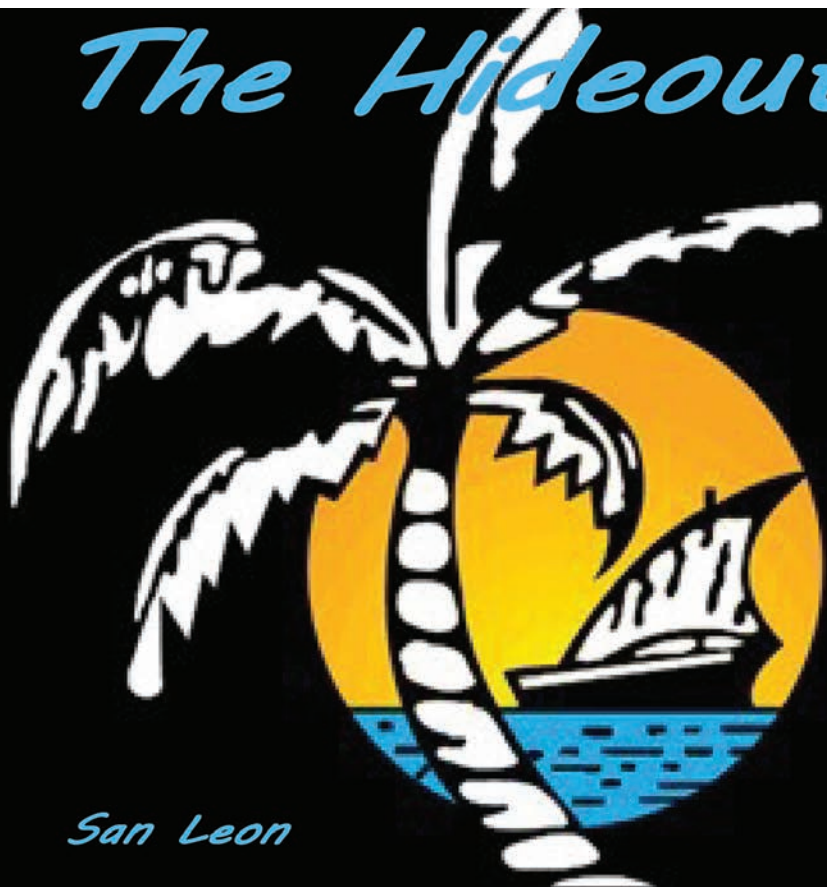
An employee may ask you for family medical history to ensure your baby receives the appropriate care. If you

leave your baby at a fire or EMS station, they may be taken to a hospital for any necessary medical attention. Remember, if you leave your unharmed infant at a Safe Haven, you will not face prosecution for abandonment or neglect.

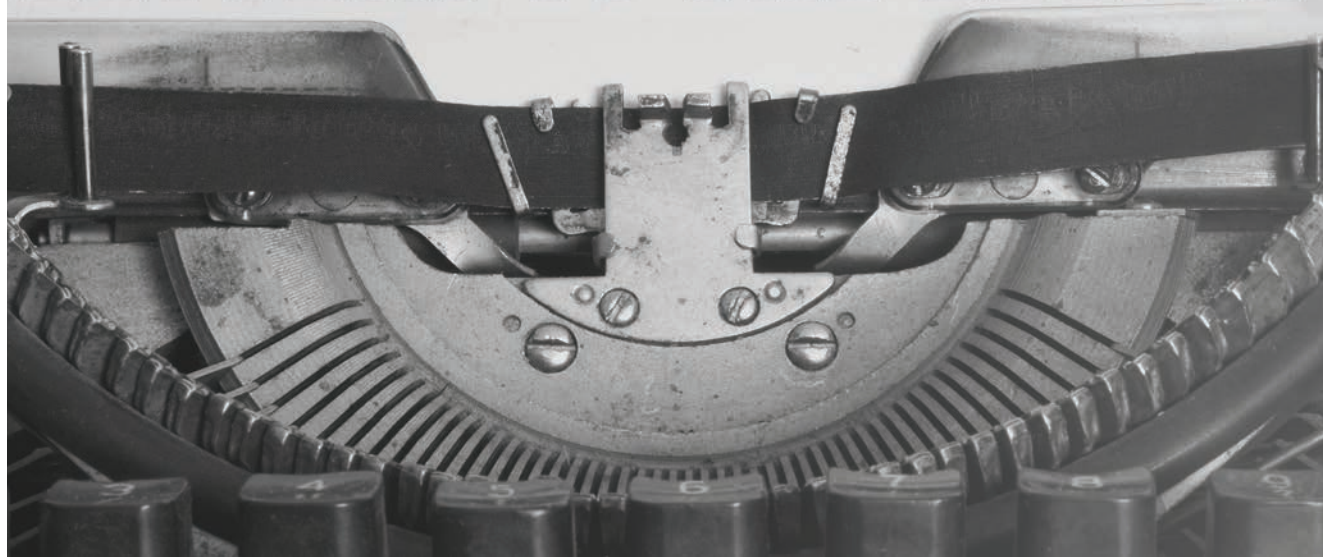

It seems the fish are getting ready for winter and get more aggressive with the way they eat.

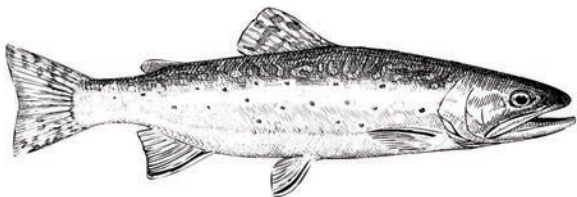
Several speckled trout have been caught around San Leon all summer, some of which are under legal size and must be released.

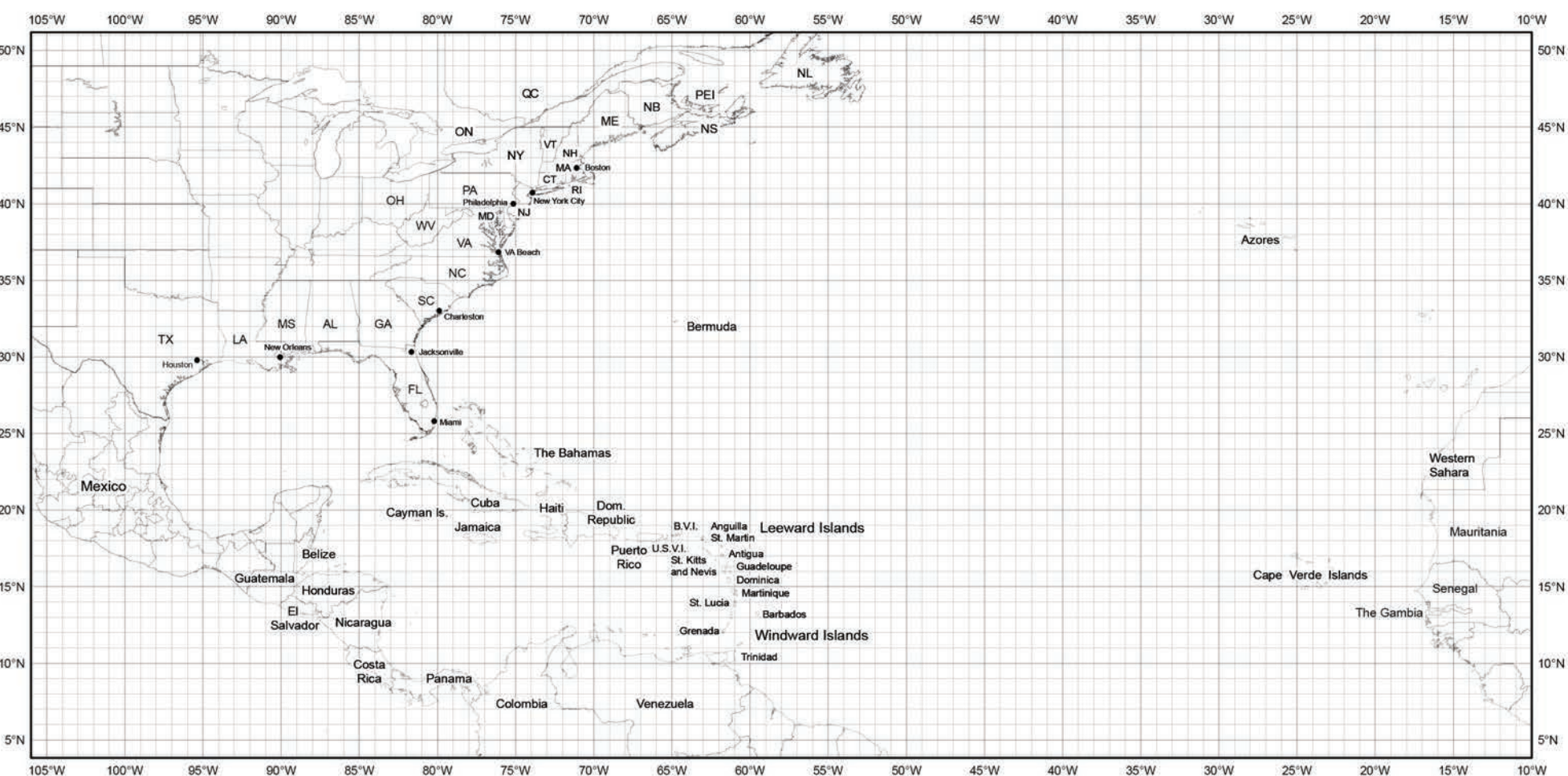

Attention San Leon Residential Customers:

Effective August 31, 2024, Texas Pride will no longer be our trash/recycle provider.

Starting September 2024, Decker Disposal out of Bacliff will be handling the trash. They are going to be purchasing trash cans, but it will take around 30 days for them to get delivered. For the time being please use a personal can or set the bags out on the trash collection day. There will be changes to the collection dates- that information is included in the map at the bottom of this page. There will not be a recycling day for San Leon; if you wish to recycle, please contact Decker Disposal, as they have recycling bins at their office.
